And whereas (1) Chandrasekera Adikari Mudiyanselage Marinu Etana, (2) Chandrasekera Adikari Mudiyanselage Menikhamy, (3) Chandrasekara Adikari Mudiyanselage Punchi Menika, and (4) Chandrasekara Adikari Mudiyanselage Urudihamy, all of Munnessaram, made claim thereto, and whereas the said claimants have withdrawn their claims to the said land, I, Walter Ernest Wait, Assistant Government Agent of the Puttalam and Chilaw Districts of the North-Western Province, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 10th day of March, 1917, order and declare, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, that the said land, as more fully described herein below, is the property of the Crown.
