ABSTRACTS OF SEASON REPORTS.

SEASON REPORTS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY, 1917.

WESTERN PROVINCE.

COLOMBO DISTRICT.

Maha season : in some parts fields are being prepared for the maha season, and in some places fields are being sown.

Yala season : plants are thriving well, and in some places they are blossoming.

Other products : flowering and prospects of coconuts are fairly good. The estimated crop for the month is 21,308,909 nuts. Fruits and vegetables are to be had in fair quantity.

Prices of staple products : (a) imported rice is sold at Rs. 5 to Rs. 6·50 per bushel ; (b) coconuts are sold at Rs. 22 to Rs. 28 per 1,000 nuts.

Harvest prospects : generally good.

Rainfall : there was sufficient rain during the month.

Health of inhabitants : generally good, except for a few cases of chickenpox, enteric fever, and measles.

Health of cattle : unsatisfactory. There have been several cases of rinderpest and a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Colombo Mudaliyar's division, 3 cases of rinderpest in Siyane korale west, 6 cases of rinderpest in Alutkuru korale south, and several cases of rinderpest in Hewagam korale.

KALUTARA DISTRICT.

Paddy : the plants of the yala cultivation are in ear in some places. Some fields in the totamunes have been prepared for "mas" cultivation.

Dry grain : nothing worth reporting.

Other products : fruit and vegetables were scarce. The flowering of coconuts was good. The crop of coconuts for the month is estimated to be 3,440,000 nuts.

Prices of staple products : Coast rice, Rs. 4·25 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; country rice in Pasdun korale east, Rs. 6 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 18 to Rs. 20 per 1,000 nuts.

Remarks on harvest prospects generally : a satisfactory harvest is expected, except in the totamunes.

Rainfall at Kalutara : total, 3·90 in. ; average, ·12 in.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : there were a few cases of rinderpest and hoof-and-mouth disease in the district.

CENTRAL PROVINCE.

KANDY DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation—yala : fields are blossoming. Maha : fields are being ploughed.

Dry grain cultivation—yala : nil. Maha : chenas are in plants and blossoming in Udunuwara and Harispattu.

Hill paddy chenas are sown in Pata Dumbara. Flowering of coconuts has been fair. The estimated crop during the month is : Yatinuwara, 30,000 ; Tumpane, 15,000 ; Harispattu, 42,000 ; Pata Hewaheta, 590,550 ; Udalapata, 106,700. Crop has not been ascertained in other divisions.

Prices of staple articles : rice, Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 6 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Re. 1·50 to Re. 1·75 per bushel ; coconuts, Re. 1·50 to Rs. 5 per 100 nuts.

Health of people : good.

Health of cattle : good.

Rainfall : there was sufficient rain during the month.

NUWARA ELIYA DISTRICT.

Rainfall : Nuwara Eliya town, 8·29 in.

Paddy : some yala cultivation fields in the district are being ploughed and sown, others have young plants.

Kurakkan : no work in the chenas.

Health of population : there were a few cases of chickenpox, measles, and dysentery in some of the villages of Uda Hewaheta and Walapane, and influenza in Kotmale.

Health of cattle, &c. : there were 11 cases of rinderpest in Nuwara Eliya town, out of which 10 died and 1 is still sick. Five sheep died of anthrax at Nanu-oya.

Prices of staple articles : paddy, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; Indian corn, Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·75 per bushel ; rice (Coast), Rs. 5·50 to Rs. 8 per bushel ; rice (country), Rs. 6 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 4·50 to Rs. 7·50 per 100 nuts.

MATALE DISTRICT.

Rainfall : 6·62 inches.

Paddy : in plant.

Dry grains : dry grains are being sown in Matale South.

Coconuts : (a) flowering fair ; (b) 128,300 nuts approximate crop.

Tanks : some tanks in Matale North are empty and others are quarter full.

Health of people : good. There were a few cases of fever, chickenpox, measles, and sore-eyes.

Health of cattle : good. There were a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease in Matale South.

Prices of most of the commodities have increased slightly above pre-war prices.

SOUTHERN PROVINCE.

GALLE DISTRICT.

Yala crop is being reaped.

Dry grain is not cultivated in the district to any appreciable extent.

Coconut, tea, rubber, cinnamon, citronella, and vegetables were the general products. The estimated coconut crop for the month was 12,732,855. Vegetables produced in some parts of the district were in excess of the local demand.

Coast rice, varied from Rs. 4 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; paddy, varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; dry grain, varied from Rs. 2 to Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; coconut, varied from Rs. 15 to Rs. 20 per 1,000 nuts.

The rainfall was plentiful.

The harvest prospects are good.

The health of the people was on the whole satisfactory. Measles and chickenpox prevailed in some parts of Talpe pattu, and a few cases of enteric fever occurred in the Four Gravets.

MATARA DISTRICT.

Weather : generally wet.

Agriculture : yala crop damaged in some parts by the swarming caterpillar.

Health of people : satisfactory, except for a few cases of measles and enteric fever.

Health of cattle : good.

Food supply : rice, Rs. 6·50 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2·50 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 20 per 1,000 nuts.

HAMBANTOTA DISTRICT.

Paddy cultivation : yala crops about three months old.

Fine grain cultivation : chenas are being cleared for maha.

Weather : maximum temperature, 93·0° ; minimum temperature, 72·3° ; rainfall, 3·86 inches.

Prices of foodstuffs : country rice, Rs. 4·80 to Rs. 5·60 per bushel ; Coast rice, Rs. 5·04 to Rs. 7 per bushel ; paddy, Rs. 2·12 per bushel ; kurakkan, Rs. 2·08 per bushel ; coconuts, Rs. 20 to Rs. 40 per 1,000 nuts ; pumpkins, Rs. 30 per 100 ; plaintain bunches, Rs. 50 per 100 ; Indian corn, Re. 1 per 100 ; sweet potatoes, Re. 1·25 per cwt.

Health of people : satisfactory.

Health of cattle : there were a few cases of hoof-and-mouth disease at Hambantota.

About 280,478 coconuts were picked during the month.

Dry grains : thinaï and chamy harvest in progress, crop moderate.

Coconuts : condition of flowers and nuts moderate ; price, Rs. 3 per 100.
