







And whereas Narangaswatte Siyatu made claim thereto, and I, John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, and whereas the said claimant and I, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing dated 5th day of November, 1914, concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimant should be declared the purchaser of the said land upon payment on or before 25th day of January, 1915, to the Government Agent at Badulla, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Seven and Cents Fifty only (Rs. 7.50), as the purchase amount of the said land, and whereas the said amount has been duly paid by the said claimant, he is hereby, in pursuance of the agreement aforementioned, declared to be the purchaser of the said land, as more fully described herein below.

# Description of the Land referred to.

The land commonly called or known as Talagahawatta, situated in the village of Ritigahaduwa, in the Kandukara korale of the Buttala division, in the Province of Uva, containing in extent 1 acre, and shown as lot 14F in preliminary plan 261 and in the annexed diagram; and bounded as follows: on the north by Batalawattegoda to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the east by Talagahawatta sold to Dissanayaka Mudiyanselage Dingiri Menika under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the south by Heladeiyannekumbura claimed by Narangahawatte Siyatu and others; on the west by Talgahawattehena to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances.
