


Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Wewapaulawatta (road reservation), situate in the village of Ihala Kiniyama, in the Kiniyama korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
