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## Part II.—Legal.

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### PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 32 of 1917.

An Ordinance to amend "The Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915."

JOHN ANDERSON.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Housing and Town Improvement (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 32 of 1917."

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

2 The following amendments shall be made in section 2 of the principal Ordinance:

- (a) At the end of the definition of "construction" there shall be added the words "and the provision of access to the street or thoroughfare."
- (b) After the definition of "cost of construction" there shall be added the words "and in the case of the provision of access the cost involved in the acquisition of any land necessary for the purpose."

Amendment of sub-section (2) of section 6 of the principal Ordinance.

3 The following words shall be added to sub-section (2) of section 6 of the principal Ordinance: "but the said expression shall not include—

- "(a) The re-roofing in whole or in part with cadjan or any substance of similar character of any building or part of a building; or
- "(b) The re-erection in whole or in part of any wall of any thatched mud and wattle building, or any part thereof, rendered unfit for habitation by stress of weather or other similar cause; or
- "(c) Any repair or minor alteration as to which it shall have been declared by public notice on the order of the Chairman that the consent of the Chairman will not be required under this section."

Addition of sub-section to section 7 of the principal Ordinance.

4 The following sub-section shall be added to section 7 of the principal Ordinance :

(4) An alteration shall be deemed to cause a building to conflict with any provision of this or any other Ordinance in any case in which the construction of the building, in such a manner as to include the alteration, would be in conflict with such provision.

Amendment of section 18 of the principal Ordinance.

5 (1) In section 18, sub-section (4), of the principal Ordinance, in the second paragraph, after the words " provided that " there shall be inserted the words " in the case of a public street."

(2) Immediately after sub-section (4) of the said section there shall be added the following paragraph :

Where application is made for sanction to re-erect any building which projects beyond any street line so defined or to re-erect any part thereof which so projects, the Chairman may require that such building shall be set back to the street line.

(3) In the final paragraph of the said section, for the words " wholly or mainly " there shall be substituted the words " to a substantial extent."

(4) The following paragraph shall be added to the section at the end thereof :

For the purposes of this section the re-erection of a building includes the re-erection of any wall or part of a wall forming part of the building or of any other support to the roof, or the erection of any new wall or other support to the roof.

The term " re-erection " includes the restoration of any wall or any part of a wall or of any support to a building which has been demolished or otherwise destroyed to or within a distance of five feet from the ground, but does not include any operation which, in the opinion of the Chairman, may reasonably be considered a repair to the wall or support.

Amendment of section 19 of the principal Ordinance.

6 In section 19 of the principal Ordinance, after the word " plans " there shall be inserted the words " and sections," and for the word " houses " there shall be substituted the word " buildings."

Amendment of section 20 of the principal Ordinance.

7 In section 20 (1) (d) of the principal Ordinance, the words " or any order of the Chairman made under chapter III. of this part " shall be omitted.

Amendment of section 25 of the principal Ordinance.

8 Section 25 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the elimination of the second proviso to sub-section (8) and by the addition of the following sub-sections :

(8 A) Where application is made to the local authority by the owners of one-third of the total frontages abutting upon any street or any defined part of a street that any work of construction shall be undertaken with reference to such street or part of a street, with a view to the same being declared a public street under sub-section (8) hereof, the local authority may require, as a condition of its assent to such application, that the said street or part of a street shall be widened to such extent as it may deem necessary, and in any such case the widening of the street shall be deemed to be a work of construction within the meaning of this section, and the cost of construction shall include the cost of demolishing and re-erecting any boundary wall and of any compensation payable under the next succeeding sub-section.

Provided that no work of construction involving any such widening shall be undertaken if objection is made thereto under sub-section (2) hereof by the owners of more than one-half of the total frontages abutting on the street or part of a street.

(8 B) Compensation shall be payable in respect of any building or part of a building demolished for the purpose of any such widening, but the amount of such compensation may be set off against any apportionment due from the owner of any premises in respect of which the compensation is payable.

- Amendment of section 29 of the principal Ordinance.
- 9 In section 29 of the principal Ordinance, for the word "owner" there shall be substituted the word "corner."
- Amendment of section 42 (8) of the principal Ordinance.
- 10 In section 42, sub-section (8), of the principal Ordinance, for the words "with the assistance of assessors and" there shall be substituted the words "without the assistance of assessors, but."
- Amendment of section 46 (2) (c) of the principal Ordinance.
- 11 In section 46 (2) (c) of the principal Ordinance, for the word "framed" there shall be substituted the word "formed."
- Amendment of section 48 of the principal Ordinance.
- 12 The following amendments shall be made in section 48 of the principal Ordinance :
- (a) For sub-section (2) (a) the following shall be substituted :
- (a) For the inclusion within the street of strips of the property situated upon the street or any part thereof to the extent necessary to give effect to the scheme.
- (b) In paragraphs (b) and (d) of sub-section (2), for the word "dedicated" there shall be substituted the word "included."
- Amendment of section 51 (1) (c) of the principal Ordinance.
- 13 In section 51 (1) (c) of the principal Ordinance, after the words "particulars of the scheme" there shall be inserted the words "including the estimated cost thereof."
- Amendment of section 63 (1) (b) of the principal Ordinance.
- 14 In section 63 (1) (b) of the principal Ordinance the words "or other information" shall be omitted.
- Amendment of section 75 of the principal Ordinance.
- 15 In section 75 of the principal Ordinance, for the words "the Chairman of the local authority, if the Health Officer has certified in writing," there shall be substituted the words "the Police Magistrate, if he is satisfied."
- Amendment of section 78 of the principal Ordinance.
- 16 The following amendments shall be made in section 78 of the principal Ordinance :
- (a) At the commencement of the section there shall be inserted the words "subject to the provisions of section 76."
- (b) For the word "shall" in all places of the section in which the word occurs there shall be substituted the word "may."
- Amendment of section 97 of the principal Ordinance.
- 17 The following amendments shall be made in section 97 of the principal Ordinance :
- (a) For the word "adult" there shall be substituted the words "person over ten years of age."
- (b) For the words "cubical space of three hundred and sixty feet" there shall be substituted the words "free air space of three hundred and sixty cubic feet."
- (c) For the words "cubical space of one hundred and eighty feet" there shall be substituted the words "free air space of one hundred and eighty cubic feet."
- Addition of new section to the principal Ordinance.
- Masonry boundary walls, &c.
- 18 The following sections shall be added to the principal Ordinance :
106. (1) No person shall erect any masonry boundary wall or gateway—
- (a) Within the street lines of any street for which street lines have been defined ; or
- (b) In the case of any street for which no street lines have been defined, within twenty feet of the centre of the street, unless in such case he shall have received the written permission of the Chairman.
- (2) In the case last mentioned the Chairman may require as a condition of such permission that the owner of the premises shall execute an undertaking that no compensation shall be payable in respect of such boundary wall or gateway in the event of the land on which such wall or gateway is situated being acquired for public purposes, or being included in the street under this Ordinance.
- (3) Any person who shall erect any masonry boundary wall or gateway in contravention of this section shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees, and the court upon

such conviction, in the event of the person convicted declining to execute the undertaking referred to in this section, may make an order in the terms of such undertaking, and every such order may be registered, and shall be binding upon the land in the same manner as an undertaking under this section.

Register of obligations affecting land or buildings.

107. (1) In any case in which in pursuance of this Ordinance, or of any improvement scheme sanctioned under this Ordinance, any undertaking is executed, or any condition is assented to, or any obligation is assumed affecting any land or building comprised in any improvement scheme, or within the administrative limits of any local authority, in any deed or instrument the parties to which are either the Chairman and the owner of the land or building affected or the respective owners of two or more of such lands or buildings, then upon such deed or instrument being registered in the office of the local authority, every such undertaking, condition, or obligation shall be binding upon the land or building affected in accordance with the tenor thereof into whosoever ownership or possession the said land or building may at any time pass.

(2) It shall be the duty of every local authority to maintain a register for the purposes of this section, and every such register shall be open to inspection at all reasonable times by any person interested.

(3) It shall be the duty of the Chairman to cause certified copies of all deeds and instruments entered in such register to be registered in the office of the Registrar of Lands, and all such copies shall be registered free of any charge or duty.

Amendment of schedule, rule 3 (a).

19 The following words shall be added to paragraph (a) of rule 3 of the schedule to the principal Ordinance: "and shall in no place be less than seven feet in height."

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 33 of 1917.

An Ordinance to prohibit melting down of Gold and Silver Coin.

JOHN ANDERSON.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to prohibit the melting down of gold and silver coin: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.  
Commencement and duration.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Coinage Ordinance, No. 33 of 1917," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette*, appoint, and shall continue in force during the present war, and until such time as the Governor shall terminate the same by Proclamation in that behalf.

Penalty for melting and breaking up gold or silver coins.

2 (1) Any person who shall melt, break up, or use otherwise than as currency any gold or silver coin which is legal tender in the Colony shall be guilty of an offence, and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand rupees, or to imprisonment of either description for a period not exceeding two years, or to both, and to the forfeiture of the coin in respect of which the offence was committed or of any metal or other article derived therefrom, together with any other metal or article with which the material of such coin may be intermingled.

(2) Any person who knowingly uses, possesses, or deals with any metal or article which he knows or has reasonable cause to believe to be derived from any coin or to be the product in whole or in part of any coin which has been dealt with in contravention of this Ordinance shall be guilty of an offence, and liable to the same penalties and forfeiture as those prescribed by the last preceding sub-section.

(3) This section shall not apply to any coins in actual use as personal ornaments at the date of the passing of this Ordinance.

**An Ordinance to amend "The Rural Schools Ordinance, 1907."**

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Rural Schools Ordinance, 1907," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Rural Schools (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 34 of 1917."

New sub-section (1) (a 1) added.

2 After sub-section (1) (a) of section 20 of the principal Ordinance the following sub-section shall be added, and shall be numbered (a 1):

(a 1) Requiring any person who desires to open a school or give instruction in English or in any other language in any schoolroom or in any building not previously used by him for the purpose to any class or classes attended by children of school-going age to report to the nearest Education Inspector or Sub-Inspector at least one month before commencing such school work or instruction, and thereafter to supply such information as may be required by the Director of Education with regard to his class or classes and the course of instruction he proposes to give therein.

Amendment of sub-section (1) (b).

3 The following amendments shall be made in paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section 20 of the principal Ordinance:

- (a) At the commencement of the said paragraph there shall be inserted the words following: "Subject to such exceptions and qualifications as may be contained in the said by-laws."
- (b) In line 2 of the said paragraph, for the word "twelve" there shall be substituted the word "fourteen."
- (c) After the word "old" in line 2 of the said paragraph there shall be added the words following: "or in the case of girls between the ages of six years and twelve years old."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend Ordinance No. 11 of 1894, intituled "An Ordinance to suppress Intermeddlers with Suitors in Courts of Justice": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Intermeddlers with Suitors (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 35 of 1917," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall by Proclamation appoint.

Amendment of preamble of the principal Ordinance.

2 For the words "touts and vagrants" in line 2 of the preamble to the principal Ordinance the word "persons" shall be substituted:

Substitution of new section for section 5 of the principal Ordinance.

3 For section 5 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted:

Persons without proper excuse accosting persons having business, actual or prospective, in courts triable summarily.

5. Any person who, without proper excuse, the proof whereof shall lie on him, accosts, or attempts by words, signs, or otherwise to meddle with, any suitor or other person having business, actual or prospective, in any court, with respect to his suit or business, shall be guilty of an offence, and be liable on conviction to be punished with a fine not exceeding one hundred rupees.
