MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907."

reamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1917," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Amendment of section 9.

2 In section 9 of the principal Ordinance, after the words "Superintendent of Police" there shall be added the words "President of a Village Tribunal."

Amendment of section 11.

3 The following proviso shall be added at the end and in continuation of section 11 of the principal Ordinance :

Provided, however, that Village Tribunals shall have concurrent jurisdiction with Police Courts to try all offences under this Ordinance; and every Village Tribunal shall have power in respect of such offences to impose a fine not exceeding twenty rupees, or, in default of payment, imprisonment of either description for a term not exceeding two weeks.

4 In section 28 of "The Village Communities Ordinance, 1889," the paragraph "(10) Offences under 'The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907,'" is hereby repealed.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

In 1908, by Ordinance No. 3 of that year, Village Tribunals were given jurisdiction to try offences under "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907." It appears to have been overlooked that the amendment was in such a form as to give these Tribunals exclusive jurisdiction for the purpose of such offences, instead of concurrent jurisdiction with the Police Courts, as was probably intended. The present Ordinance gives concurrent jurisdiction to both Village Tribunals and Police Courts by means of an amendment of the principal Ordinance.
