**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE
MONTH OF AUGUST, 1917.**

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

Births.

2. The number of births registered was 1,337 (670 males and 667 females), and was equal to an annual rate of 25·46 per 1,000, against 23·40 in the preceding month, 26·08 in the corresponding month of last year, and 26·23 the average of the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 14·86 in Nuwara Eliya to 59·20 in Batticaloa.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 492 (250 males and 242 females), and were equal to an annual rate* of 21·62 per 1,000, against 17·58 in the preceding month, 19·57 in the corresponding month of last year, and 21·00 the average of the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 10·53 in Kollupitiya to 21·18 in Wellawatta.

Deaths.

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,579 (841 males and 738 females). There were 1,236 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 25·65 per 1,000, against 25·34 in the preceding month, 29·26 in the corresponding month of last year, and 29·55 the average for the month of August in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 60·70 in Kegalla to 8·91 in Nuwara Eliya.

5. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered were 548 (312 males and 236 females). There were 448 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual rate* of 22·84 per 1,000, against 21·87 in the preceding month, 30·78 in the corresponding month of last year, and 30·30 the average for the month of August in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 23·30 in Wellawatta to 11·75 in St. Paul's.

6. The stillbirths registered were 101 (55 males and 46 females), against 70 in the preceding month.

Infant Mortality.

7. The mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 208 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending August 31, 1917. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 232, against 260 in the preceding month, 231 in the corresponding month of last year, and 263 the average of the corresponding months since 1908.

8. The mortality of infants in the city of Colombo was 202 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending August 31, 1917. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 209, against 305 in the preceding month, 251 in the corresponding month of last year, and 276 the average of the corresponding months since 1908.

Causes of Death.

9. The highest death-rate was attributed to *Pneumonia*, to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 8 per cent. was due to *Debility*, 7 per cent. each to *Phthisis*, *Convulsions*, and *Diarrhoea*, 5 per cent. to *Anchylostomiasis*, 4 per cent. each to *Dysentery* and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, 3 per cent. each to *Prematurity*, *Enteritis*, and *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, 2 per cent. each to *Enteric Fever* and *Bronchitis*, and 1 per cent. to *Tetanus*.

10. In Colombo the highest death-rate was from *Pneumonia*, closely followed by *Phthisis*, to each of which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, *Convulsions* caused 9 per cent., *Debility* 5 per cent., *Enteritis* and *Dysentery* 4 per cent. each, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* and *Enteric Fever* 3 per cent. each, *Anchylostomiasis* 2 per cent., and *Diarrhoea*, *Tetanus*, and *Bronchitis* 1 per cent. each. Two deaths from *Plague* were registered, against 4 in the previous month and 33 in the corresponding month of last year.

11. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The most prevalent infectious disease during the month was *Measles*, of which 167 cases were reported (124 in Colombo, 35 in Kandy), followed by *Phthisis* 79 (60 in Colombo, 12 in Galle), *Chickenpox* 69 (31 in Colombo, 11 in Gampola, 9 in Kandy), *Enteric Fever* 55 (31 in Colombo, 14 in Galle, 5 in Moratuwa), *Continued Fever* 18 (10 in Colombo, 4 in Moratuwa), *Mumps* 9 (4 in Colombo), *Diphtheria* 4 (in Colombo), *Dysentery* 4 (3 in Galle), *Plague* 1 (in Colombo), and *Whooping Cough* 1 (in Colombo).

Meteorology.

12. *Rainfall.*—Hatton and Dikoya recorded the highest rainfall (16·04 inches), followed by Gampola (14·63 inches). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 13·06 inches in Ratnapura to 0·28 of an inch in Puttalam. Colombo recorded 2·28 inches.

13. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 61·1° in Nuwara Eliya to 84·1° in Trincomalee, and was 81·1° in Colombo.
