Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Copyright (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918."

Addition of new sub-section.

2 The following sub-section shall be added to the section which by the said Ordinance was substituted for section 14 of the Imperial Copyright Act, 1911, and shall be numbered (6) :

(6) All regulations made under this section shall be subject to the approval of the Governor in Executive Council.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Rubber Thefts Prevention Ordinance, 1908": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Rubber Thefts Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918."

Amendment of section 2 of principal Ordinance.

2 The following words shall be added to the definition of "licensed premises" in section 2 of the principal Ordinance : "and also includes any place at which a licensed dealer is authorized to receive, store, or sell rubber for the purposes of his business by endorsement of the Government Agent upon his license."

Extension of provisions of principal Ordinance to persons taking delivery of rubber for sale or shipment.

3 In section 3 of the principal Ordinance, after the words "to purchase rubber" there shall be inserted the words "or to take delivery of rubber for sale or shipment," and after the words "who purchases rubber" there shall be inserted the words "or takes delivery of rubber for sale or shipment."

Amendment of section 8 A of principal Ordinance.

4 In section 8 A of the principal Ordinance, after the words "in the form C in the schedule hereto" and after the words "the form D in the said schedule" there shall be inserted the words "or in such other form as may be prescribed."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to give effect to certain suggestions made by the Ceylon Chamber of Commerce with respect to the recently enacted Rubber Thefts Prevention (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 39 of 1917.

2. Section 2 relaxes the provision which requires that a licensed dealer shall only deal at his licensed premises. Colombo business firms engaged in the sale or shipment of rubber will, in order to comply with the new provisions, require to take only licenses as dealers, and obviously cannot be expected to store at their offices the rubber which they handle.

3. With regard to section 3, the Committee of the Chamber of Commerce is of opinion that in order to make the section of the new Ordinance complete, the obligation to require that all rubber dealt with shall be accompanied by an indication of its origin, or a certificate that it has been already entered in the books of a licensed dealer, should apply to all persons who receive rubber at their business premises for sale or shipment. This obligation probably extends to brokers already, but section 3 declares this in express terms.

4. Section 4 provides for the adaptation of the forms prescribed by the new Ordinance to special circumstances or business requirements.
