VITAL STATISTICS OF CEYLON.

**REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL OF MARRIAGES, BIRTHS, AND DEATHS:
FOR THE THIRD QUARTER OF 1917.**

I.—Population.

THE estimated population on the last day of the quarter was 4,608,672, showing an increase of 19,034 persons on that of the preceding quarter, as the result of an excess of 13,918 births over deaths and of 5,116 more arrivals than departures of Indian coolies. The excess in births was shared fairly evenly throughout the districts, though not in Mannar and Puttalam.

2. The arrivals and departures of Indian coolies were 12,326 and 7,210 respectively, as against averages of 32,280 and 15,870 for the corresponding quarters of the past ten years.

II.—Marriages.

3. 7,014 marriages (5,208 General and 1,806 Kandyan) were registered during the quarter, as against 5,279 in the preceding quarter, 6,439 in the corresponding quarter of last year, and 6,460 the average for the corresponding quarters of the past ten years. (Table I. gives their distribution by Provinces and districts.)

III.—Births.

4. The births registered during the quarter numbered 41,546, representing an annual rate of 35·9 per 1,000. This rate, though 1·5 below that of the previous quarter, was slightly above the birth-rate of the corresponding quarter of 1916 and 1·8 above the mean average. The decrease in the Provinces was more noticeable in the North-Central, the Western, and the Southern and in the Districts of Anuradhapura, Galle, and Matara. The highest birth-rate, 51·7, recorded was in Mullaittivu District, and the lowest, 28·6, in Colombo District. The estates rate was 51·9, and the urban, including Colombo, 24·23. (For detailed statistics see Tables I. to V. in the Appendix.) 506 births of twins, 6 of triplets, and 4 of quadruplets were registered during the quarter, as against 420 of twins only in the previous quarter.

IV.—Deaths.

5. The deaths registered were 27,628, equivalent to an annual rate of 23·9 per 1,000. Though slightly higher than the last quarter's death-rate, it denoted a decrease of 3·6 on the rate for the corresponding quarter of 1916 and of 4·6 on the mean average. The provincial rate of mortality was highest in the Uva, 38·1, whilst the Western continued to record the lowest, which for this quarter was 19·9. In the districts Mannar had the highest rate, 40·7, and Chilaw the lowest, 15·9. The estate rate was the highest in Matara District as usual, though 37·0, the quarter's rate, as compared with the previous quarter's indicated a decrease of 16·0 per mille. The rate for the towns was 24·49, and ranged between 53·18 in Kegalla and 10·74 in Chilaw. 272 stillbirths (149 males and 123 females), as against 289 in the previous quarter, were registered.

V.—Infant Mortality.

6. The deaths of children below the age of one year to every 1,000 births registered during the year ended the last day of the quarter gave a ratio of 162 for all races, as against 156 for the previous quarter. The highest rate of infantile mortality among the Sinhalese was 201 in the Batticaloa District, among the Tamils 308 in the Mannar District, and among the Moors 280 in the Batticaloa District. The lowest rate among the Sinhalese was 111 in the Kegalla District, among the Tamils 154 in the Trincomalee District, and among the Moors 156 in the Puttalam District. The rate in the estates was equal to 256, Nuwara Eliya recording 310, the highest and Kegalla, 163, the lowest. The infant death-rate in the towns was 201, and ranged between 327 in Hatton and Dikoya and 55 in Mullaittivu.

VI.—Causes of Death.

7. Of a total of 27,628 deaths shown above, 3,673 was attributed to Pyrexia, equivalent to 13 per cent. Infantile Convulsions contributed 11 per cent., Diarrhoea 10 per cent., Diseases of Skin and Cellular Tissue and Debility 7 per cent. each, Pneumonia and Rickets 5 per cent. each, Phthisis, Diseases of Pregnancy and of Childbirth, Anaemia, Intestinal Parasites, Anchyllostomiasis, Senility, and Dysentery 3 per cent. each, Dropsy 2 per cent., Premature Birth, Malaria and Malarial Cachexia, and Acute Rheumatic Fever 1 per cent. each. The Plague figures for the quarter 11 (10 in Colombo and 1 in Kalutara), as against 56 in the previous quarter and 97 in the corresponding quarter of 1916, suggest a satisfactory arrest of the spread of this dire epidemic. 2 deaths from Smallpox (1 in Jaffna and 1 in Batticaloa) and 1 from Chickenpox in Nuwara Eliya were registered. (For detailed statistics see Table VI.)

8. Affections produced by external causes:—

(a) *Suicide*.—Fifty-seven deaths resulted from suicide, as against 77 in the previous quarter and 57 in the corresponding quarter of 1916.

(b) *Homicide.*—Forty-seven deaths were caused by Homicide, as against 50 in the previous quarter and 38 in the corresponding quarter of 1916.

(c) *Executions.*—Fourteen persons underwent the extreme penalty of the law (6 in Colombo, 2 in Kandy, and 6 in Galle), as against a total of 5 in the preceding quarter and 3 in the corresponding quarter of 1916.

(d) Of 433 deaths from accidents and other affections produced by external causes, 86 were due to drowning (of these, 35 in wells and 5 in pits), 74 to falling from trees, 52 to burns (of these, 9 by kerosine oil lamps upsetting). Snake-bite caused 51, injuries by animals 15. 30 deaths resulted from vehicular traffic (13 from being run over by carts, 11 by trains, 6 by motor cars). Landslides caused 5.

9. *Causes of Deaths in Estates.*—The highest percentage of deaths was due to Debility, which contributed 21 per cent., Diarrhoea caused 12 per cent., Anchylostomiasis 11 per cent., Dysentery 10 per cent., Pneumonia 9 per cent., Infantile Convulsions 8 per cent., Senility 4 per cent., Prematurity and Diseases of Pregnancy 3 per cent. each, Bronchitis 2 per cent., Phthisis, Enteritis, Malaria and Malarial Cachexia, and Dropsy 1 per cent. each. (For detailed statistics see Table VII.)

10. *Causes of Deaths in Towns.*—In the 33 proclaimed towns, including Colombo, the highest number of deaths was from Pneumonia, which caused 11 per cent., Convulsions caused 8 per cent., Phthisis 7 per cent., Diarrhoea 6 per cent., Anchylostomiasis and Infantile Debility 5 per cent. each, Enteritis, Dysentery, Malaria and Malarial Cachexia 4 per cent. each, Prematurity, Bright's Disease and Nephritis 3 per cent. each, Enteric Fever and Bronchitis and Accidents or Negligence 2 per cent. each, and Puerperal Septicæmia and Tetanus 1 per cent. each. (For detailed statistics see Table VIII.)
