**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE  
MONTH OF JANUARY, 1918.**

**REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.**

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

**Births.**

2. The number of births registered was 1,736 (901 males and 835 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 32·22 per 1,000, against 28·70 in the preceding month, 34·45 in the corresponding month of last year, and 32·58 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 11·23 in Vavuniya to 56·90 in Kegalla.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 603 (314 males and 289 females), and were equal to an annual rate\* of 25·66 per 1,000, against 22·24 in the preceding month, 29·71 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·54 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 10·91 in Kollupitiya to 39·44 in Wellawatta.

**Deaths.**

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,688 (917 males and 771 females). There were 1,386 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 28·02 per 1,000, against 27·37 in the preceding month, 28·48 in the corresponding month of last year, and 34·04 the average for the month of January in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 92·21 in Nawalapitiya to 1·77 in Nuwara Eliya.

5. In the city of Colombo the number of deaths registered was 609 (342 males and 267 females). There were 540 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual rate\* of 26·66 per 1,000, against 28·04 in the preceding month, 25·65 in the corresponding month of last year, and 31·20 the average for the month of January in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 26·52 in Wellawatta to 7·79 in Kollupitiya.

6. The stillbirths registered numbered 94 (45 males and 49 females), against 105 in the preceding month.

**Infant Mortality.**

7. The mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 276 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending January 31, 1918. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 232, against 247 in the preceding month, 207 in the corresponding month of last year, and 282 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

8. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 297 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending January 31, 1918. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 242, against 283 in the preceding month, 191 in the corresponding month of last year, and 305 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

**Causes of Death.**

9. The highest mortality was attributed to *Debility*, to which 14 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 9 per cent. was due to *Pneumonia*, 8 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 6 per cent. each to *Phthisis*, *Diarrhœa*, and *Anchylostomiasis*, 4 per cent. each to *Enteritis* and *Malaria and Malarial Cachexia*. 3 per cent. each to *Dysentery*, *Prematurity*, and *Bright's Disease and Nephritis*, 2 per cent. each to *Enteric Fever* and *Bronchitis*, and 1 per cent. to *Tetanus*.

10. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Debility*, to which 10 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 9 per cent. each was due to *Pneumonia* and *Phthisis*, 7 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 5 per cent. to *Enteritis*, 3 per cent. to *Bright's Disease and Nephritis*, 2 per cent. each to *Diarrhœa*, *Enteric Fever*, *Prematurity*, and *Tetanus*, and 1 per cent. to *Anchylostomiasis*, 15 deaths from *Plague* were registered, against 6 in the preceding month and 19 in the corresponding month of last year.

11. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Chickenpox*, of which 150 cases were reported (76 in Colombo, 26 in Trincomalee, 12 in Galle), followed by *Phthisis* 81 (73 in Colombo, 7 in Galle), *Enteric Fever* 62 (30 in Colombo, 12 in Moratuwa, 10 in Galle), *Continued Fever* 35 (12 in Moratuwa, 10 in Colombo), *Measles* 20 (16 in Kandy and 2 in Colombo), *Plague* 13 (in Colombo), *Diphtheria* 6 (2 in Colombo, 2 in Moratuwa), *Dysentery* 5 (2 in Moratuwa, 2 in Galle), *Mumps* 3 (in Colombo), *Whooping cough* 2 (in Galle);

**Meteorology.**

12. *Rainfall.*—Vavuniya recorded the highest rainfall (16·69 inches), followed by Mullaittivu (15·98 inches). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 15·49 inches in Batticaloa to 2·70 inches in Negombo. Colombo recorded 4·25 inches.

13. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 57·6° in Nuwara Eliya to 78·1° in Mannar, and was 77·5° in Colombo.
