An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1916-17.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 24 of 1916 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Sixty-three million Five hundred and Seventy-three thousand and Fifty-one rupees should be charged upon the revenue and other funds of this Island for the Contingent Service of the financial year 1916-17, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said period: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 4,168,944.35 to be charged upon the revenue of the Island for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1916-17.

1 That a sum not exceeding Four million One hundred and Sixty-eight thousand Nine hundred and Forty-four rupees and Thirty-five cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of the Colony for the services hereinafter mentioned, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed:
