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## DRAFT ORDINANCE.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 9 of 1872.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend in certain particulars Ordinance No. 9 of 1872, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Commissions of Inquiry Ordinance, 1903," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance, and this Ordinance and the said Ordinance may be cited together as "The Commissions of Inquiry Ordinances, 1872 and 1903."

2 For the words "shall be liable to the pains and penalties of perjury" at the end of section 3 of the principal Ordinance the following words shall be substituted, namely, "shall be guilty of the offence of giving false evidence under chapter XI. of the Ceylon Penal Code, and shall be liable to the penalties therein prescribed."

Amendment of section 3 regarding penalty.

Presumption on production of record of evidence taken by commissioner.

3 The following section shall be added to section 3 of the principal Ordinance and numbered 3 A :

3 A The presumptions which, under section 80 of "The Ceylon Evidence Ordinance, 1895," are applicable to the documents therein mentioned shall apply to every document produced before any court purporting to be a record or memorandum of the evidence or any part of the evidence given by a witness examined, whether before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, by a commissioner appointed under this Ordinance or by any person empowered by law to exercise the powers of such commissioner with regard to administering oaths or affirmations to persons examined before him and purporting to be signed by such commissioner or person.
