DRAFT RDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1903.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 18 of 1902 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Nineteen million Seven hundred and Thirty-nine thousand Eight hundred and Sixty-nine rupees should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the contingent service of the year One thousand Nine hundred and Three, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said year: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs.1,694,718°06 to be charged upon the revenue of the island for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1903.

1 That a sum not exceeding One million Six hundred and Ninety-four thousand Seven hundred and eighteen rupees and six cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island and other funds of the colony for the services hereinafter mentioned; and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the details of the estimates specified in the Schedule A hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order.

And to receive credit in his accounts for the payments made in pursuance thereof.

- 2 The Treasurer of the said island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues of the said island.
- 3 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be therein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 6 of 1903.

An Ordinance to further amend "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, 1884."

WEST RIDGEWAY.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Ordinance," in certain particulars: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Ceylon Paper Currency (Amendment) Ordinance, 1903," and shall be read and construed as one with the principal Ordinance, and the principal Ordinance and the Ordinances amending the same and this Ordinance may be cited together as "The Ceylon Paper Currency Ordinances, 1884 to 1903."

Amendment of section 11 of principal Ordinance regarding issue of currency notes.

- 2 For section 11 of the principal Ordinance, as amended by section 3 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1901, the following section shall be substituted:
 - (1) The commissioners shall, on the demand of any person, issue currency notes in exchange for the amount thereof in silver rupees of India.
 - (2) The commissioners may also issue such notes in exchange for the amount thereof in gold coin, which is legal tender in Ceylon, under any Order of His Majesty the King in Council; but the commissioners may decline to do so whenever it is inexpedient in their judgment to increase the amount of gold coin held as reserve under this Ordinance.
