#### DRAFT ORDINANCE.

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance for making final provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1202.

Preamble.

HEREAS by an Ordinance No. 19 of 1902 it was enacted that a sum of Rs. 1,968,185 29 should be charged upon the revenue of this island for the Supplementary Contingent Services of the year One thousand Nine hundred and Two, in addition to the sum of Rs. 21,326,401 provided by the Ordinance No. 16 of 1901: And whereas an expenditure of Rs. 112,744 12 was incurred and brought to account for the Contingent Services of the year 1902, for which provision is not made by the aforesaid Ordinances: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

R. 112,744-12 charged upon the revenue of this ieland of the year 1902 for the final Supplementary Contingent Service of that year,

1 That a sum not exceeding One hundred and Twelve thousand Seven hundred and Forty-four rupees and Twelve cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue of this island of the said year 1902, for the services hereinafter mentioned; the said expenditure being in conformity with the schedule hereunto annexed, whereof the following is an abstract:
