VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE MONTH OF APRIL, 1918.

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

Births.

2. The number of births registered was 1,415 (768 males and 647 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 27·14 per 1,000, against 28·21 in the preceding month, 28·57 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·20 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 10·83 in Ambalangoda to 75·23 in Kalmunai.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 524 (295 males and 229 females), and were equal to an annual rate* of 23·04 per 1,000, against 23·28 in the preceding month, 22·48 in the corresponding month of last year, and 22·45 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 8·37 in Kollupitiya to 30·21 in Wellawatta.

Deaths.

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,212 (640 males and 572 females). There were 993 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 20·76 per 1,000, against 24·14 in the preceding month, 26·93 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·62 the average for the month of April in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 65·71 in Nawalapitiya to 8·30 in Kegalla.

5. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 409 (234 males and 175 females). There were 353 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual rate* of 18·01 per 1,000, against 21·18 in the preceding month, 27·66 in the corresponding month of last year, and 26·43 the average for the month of April in each year since 1908. The lowest rate, 6·76, was in Kollupitiya, and the highest, 20·40, in St. Paul's.

6. The stillbirths registered numbered 88 (50 males and 38 females), against 83 in the preceding month.

Infant Mortality.

7. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 191 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending April 30, 1918. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 189, against 190 in the preceding month, 225 in the corresponding month of last year, and 237 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

8. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 201 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending April 30, 1918. Calculated on the births registered during the month only the rate was 183, against 194 in the preceding month, 279 in the corresponding month of last year, and 267 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

Causes of Death.

9. The highest mortality was attributed to *Pneumonia*, to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 10 per cent. was due to *Debility*, 8 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 6 per cent. to *Phthisis*, 4 per cent. each to *Anchylostomiasis* and *Enteritis*, 3 per cent. each to *Diarrhoea*, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, and *Enteric Fever*, 2 per cent. each to *Dysentery* and *Puerperal Septicæmia*, and 1 per cent. each to *Tetanus*, *Prematurity*, and *Bronchitis*.

10. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 12 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 9 per cent. each was due to *Convulsions* and *Phthisis*, 8 per cent. to *Debility*, 6 per cent. to *Enteritis*, 4 per cent. to *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, 3 per cent. to *Enteric Fever*, 2 per cent. each to *Dysentery*, *Puerperal Septicæmia*, *Tetanus*, and *Diarrhoea*, and 1 per cent. to *Bronchitis*. One death from *Smallpox* was registered.

11. The number of deaths registered from *Plague* was 24 (10 in Colombo and 14 in Nawalapitiya), as against 11 in the preceding month and 36 in the corresponding month of last year. This is the first time, since the outbreak of the disease in 1914, when such a large number of deaths from *Plague* was registered in a town other than Colombo.

12. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Chickenpox*, of which 319 cases were reported (175 in Colombo, 44 in Galle, 22 in Kandy, 18 in Mannar, 15 in Trincomalee, 12 in Moratuwa, 10 in Ambalangoda), followed by *Phthisis* 71 (67 in Colombo, 3 in Weligama), *Measles* 67 (38 in Kandy, 22 in Colombo), *Enteric Fever* 35 (20 in Colombo, 5 in Galle, 4 in Kandy), *Continued Fever* 30 (13 each in Colombo and Moratuwa), *Plague* 28 (16 in Nawalapitiya, 11 in Colombo, and 1 in Jaffna), *Mumps* 9 (7 in Colombo), *Smallpox* 6 (5 in Colombo and 1 in Galle), *Whooping Cough* 4 (in Colombo), *Diarrhoea* 1 (in Moratuwa), *Dysentery* 1 (in Moratuwa), and *Malarial Cachexia* 1 (in Galle).

Meteorology.

13. *Rainfall.*—Negombo recorded the highest rainfall (15·76 inches), followed by Ratnapura (10·60 inches). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 6·93 inches in Kegalla to 0·08 of an inch in Batticaloa. Colombo recorded 4·53 inches.

14. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 58·5° in Nuwara Eliya to 85·7° in Jaffna, and was 82·2° in Colombo.
