GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

“THE QUARANTINE AND PREVENTION OF DISEASES ORDINANCE, 1897.”

IT is hereby notified that His Excellency the Officer Administering the Government in Executive Council has declared the locality described in the schedule hereto to be a “diseased locality” until further notification, in terms of the regulations made under the above-mentioned Ordinance, and published in *Government Gazette* No. 6,636 of July 31, 1914.

SCHEDULE.

The portion of the Local Board town of Nawalapitiya situated within the following boundaries:—

Starting from the first $\frac{1}{4}$ milestone on the Kotmale road in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to the paddy fields, thence along the edge of the paddy fields in a westerly and north-westerly direction to a point 100 yards south-west of culvert No. 8 on the Ambagamuwa road, thence along a line running north-east through the said culvert No. 8 to a point 200 yards from the Ambagamuwa

road, thence along a line parallel to Ambagamuwa and Dolosbage roads at a distance of 200 yards from the said roads to a point in line with the overhead bridge over the railway, thence along the line of the overhead bridge and Market road to the Local Board Office, thence along a line parallel to Gampola and Kotmale roads, at a distance of 100 yards from the said roads to a point opposite the first $\frac{1}{4}$ milestone on the Kotmale road, thence to the starting point.
