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DRAFT ORDINANCES.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Law regulating the Punishment for Thefts of Prædial Products.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the law regulating the punishment for thefts of prædial products in this Colony: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Regulation of Whipping for Thefts of Prædial Products Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Substitution of new section for section 368 of the Ceylon Penal Code.

- 2 For section 368 of the Ceylon Penal Code, the following section shall be substituted:
 - 368. Whoever commits theft-
 - (a) Of any bull, cow, steer, buffalo, heifer, or calf; or
 - (b) Of any fruit, vegetable, or other prædial production, or any cultivated root or plant used or capable of being used for the food of man or beast, or for medicine, distilling, or dyeing, or in the course of any manufacture,

may, in addition to any other punishment for theft, be punished with whipping.

Amendment of section 4 of Ordinance No. 4 of 1891.

- 3 In paragraph (c) of section 4 of Ordinance No. 4 of 1891, intituled "An Ordinance to empower Police Magistrates to inflict Whipping for Theft of Prædial Products"—
 - (a) For the word "lashes" substitute the word "strokes";(b) For the words "by sections 55 and 56 of the Ceylon Penal Code" substitute the words "for the carrying out of sentences of whipping."

Amendment of section 315 of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1802" 4 The following paragraph shall be added at the end and in continuation of section 315 of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898":

Provided that in the case of any sentences of whipping inflicted under paragraph (b) of section 368 of the Ceylon Penal Code, such whipping shall be inflicted with a cane or rattan, or other like implement, and in such manner as the Governor shall at any time or from time to time direct.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of the Ordinance is to substitute strokes with a cane or a rattan for lashes with the cat in the execution of a sentence of whipping inflicted for theft of prædial products.

2. The Ordinance is introduced in accordance with the wishes of the Secretary of State for the Colonies, that in all British Colonies in which whipping is a punishment for such thefts the cat should no longer be used.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance for making provision for the Contingent Services for the Financial Year October, 1918, to September, 1919.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the contingent expenditure required for the service of the Government of this Island for the financial year October, 1918, to September, 1919, and not otherwise provided for, has been estimated at the sum of Sixty million Three hundred and Forty-six thousand and Twelve rupees: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

- 1 A sum not exceeding Sixty million Three hundred and Forty-six thousand and Twelve rupees shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of this Island for the Contingent Services for the financial year October, 1918, to September, 1919, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the Heads, of Expenditure specified in the schedule hereunto annexed.
- 2 And whereas by the 31st section of the Ordinance No. 31 of the year 1884, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, entitled 'An Ordinance to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to Public Thoroughfares in this Colony," it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to propose the estimates prepared in pursuance thereof, or such of them as to him may appear expedient, in the Ordinance for making provision for the contingent expenditure of the Colony for the ensuing year, to be dealt with in like manner as any other estimate to be so proposed: And it is thereby also provided that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 31 of 1884, for the performance of any work or works for which an estimate or estimates may have been so proposed by the Governor, and approved of by the Legislative Council, shall be distinctly stated in the Ordinance enacted for the same, and that the same shall not exceed two-thirds of the whole amount of labour due from the district or districts within which it may be required to be performed: It is enacted that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be in conformity with the estimates detailed under Head No. 40, "Public Works Annually Recurrent.
- 8 The Treasurer of the said Island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and

Rs. 60,346,012 to be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Contingent Services for the financial year October, 1918, to September, 1919.

Amount of labour to be supplied under the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884.

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order. direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues and other funds of the said Island.

And to receive credit to his accounts for the payments made in pursuance hereof. 4 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be herein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal "The Anglo-Portuguese Commercial Treaty Ordinance, No. 15 of 1917," which has ceased to be necessary: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Date of coming into operation of Ordinance.

Repeal.

1 This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date of the passing thereof.

2 "The Anglo-Portuguese Commercial Treaty Ordinance, No. 15 of 1917," is hereby repealed.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to repeal, at the instance of the Secretary of State, "The Anglo-Portuguese Commercial Treaty Ordinance, No. 15 of 1917," in view of difficulties which have arisen in connection with the application outside the United Kingdom of Article 6 of the Treaty.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Petroleum Ordinances, 1887 and 1893."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is necessary to amend "The Petroleum Ordinances, 1887 and 1893" (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinances"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Petroleum (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Addition of new section to section 19 of the principal Ordinances.

- 2 The following section shall be added immediately after section 19 of the principal Ordinances, and shall be numbered 19 (1):
 - 19. (1) The Governor in Executive Council may from time to time make rules regarding the licensing of carts for the conveyance of petroleum. Such rules may provide for the following, among other matters:

(a) The fee to be charged for the license;

- (b) The maximum quantity of petroleum which may be carried in a licensed cart;
- (c) The conditions which may be inserted in the license;
 (d) The time during which the license is to continue in

force; and
(e) The renewal of the license.

Section to validate previous acts under the principal Ordinances. 3 Upon the coming into operation of this Ordinance, it shall be deemed to have come into operation as on the date of the principal Ordinances to the intent that any rules heretofore made or purported to have been made under the provisions of the principal Ordinances shall be valid and operative, as if they had been made under the provisions of the principal Ordinances as amended by this Ordinance.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 19 of the principal Ordinances authorizes any person who is licensed to keep petroleum to hawk such petroleum, provided that the quantity conveyed at one time in any one carriage does not exceed twenty-four gallons, except when conveyed in a cart specially constructed for that purpose, which has been licensed by the local authority for the conveyance of petroleum. It is desirable that the Governor in Executive Council should have power to regulate these licenses. Section 2 of this Ordinance is intended to accomplish this.

2. Section 3 is intended to validate the charge of a fee of Rs. 25 which has been hitherto levied for the licensing of such carts, and also to validate a rule made in 1900 dealing with such licenses.
