An Ordinance to amend " The Defence Force Ordinance, 1910 " (formerly entitled " The Volunteer Ordinance, 1910 ").

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend " The Defence Force Ordinance, 1910 " : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as " The Defence Force (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall by Proclamation appoint.

Addition of new sub-section to section 12 of the principal Ordinance.

2 The following sub-section shall be added to section 12 of the principal Ordinance, the first part of the section being numbered accordingly :

(2) For the purpose of the discipline and training of all officers and soldiers of the Defence Force, whether persons to whom Part IV. of the Ordinance applies or not, the power to make regulations under this section shall include power to make regulations for all the purposes referred to in paragraph (b) of section 40, in the same manner as if such officers or soldiers were in all cases persons to whom the said part applies.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Appeals (Privy Council) Ordinance, 1909" (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Ordinance"): Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Appeals (Privy Council) (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Addition of sub-section to section 8 of the principal Ordinance.

2 The following sub-section shall be added to section 8 of the principal Ordinance, the first part thereof being numbered accordingly :

(2) The provisions of rules 21 and 25, as amended by the Order of His Majesty the King in Council dated at the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 22nd day of March, 1918, shall apply retrospectively to all appellants who have given notice of their intention to apply for conditional leave to appeal up to the date on which the Order aforesaid shall take effect in the Colony.

An Ordinance to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918."

Amendment of section 352.

2 The following proviso shall be added at the end and in continuation of section 352 of the principal Ordinance :

Provided that in no case shall such an order be made against the Attorney-General or the Solicitor-General.

Amendment of tabular statement of offences in Schedule II.

3 The tabular statement of offences in Schedule II. of the principal Ordinance shall be amended as follows :

In the statement relating to section 382 of the Ceylon Penal Code the words "Police Court, where the value of the property in respect of which the offence is committed does not exceed one hundred rupees, and where the hurt caused is simple hurt, which hurt would be otherwise triable under section 314," shall be inserted in the eighth column, immediately after the words "District Court."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of the amendment in section 2 of the Ordinance is to protect the Attorney-General and the Solicitor-General from being cast in costs by the Supreme Court when dealing with an appeal in a criminal case. These Law Officers of the Crown become parties to an appeal only when an apparent failure of justice is reported to them or is otherwise brought to their notice, and if they are of opinion that there has been a failure of justice. Their duties are *quasi-judicial*. It is desirable that they should be protected against any risk of an order casting them in costs.

2. The object of the amendment in section 3 of the Ordinance is to empower Police Courts to try summarily cases of robbery under section 382 of the Penal Code where the hurt caused is simple and otherwise triable summarily in such courts. Police Courts have jurisdiction at present to try summarily cases of robbery under section 380 of the Penal Code, provided the value of the property does not exceed Rs. 100, that is, where the value is within their ordinary jurisdiction. There seems no valid reason why Police Courts should not similarly try cases of robbery where the ingredient which constitutes the act the offence of robbery is one of simple hurt, which in other circumstances Police Courts can try summarily.
