MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Road (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Amendment of section 94 of principal Ordinance.

2 In section 94 of the principal Ordinance—
I.—For the clause beginning "(1) Whosoever shall turn or suffer to be turned loose" in line 4, and ending "unloading of any cart or boat to which it may belong" in line 11, there shall be substituted the following:

- (1 A) The owner of any ox, horse, sheep, or goat found—
(a) Straying upon any thoroughfare;
(b) Tethered without lawful right upon any thoroughfare;
(c) So tethered that such animal can make its way into any thoroughfare;
shall be guilty of an offence, unless he prove—
(i.) That he kept such animal effectually enclosed or securely tethered elsewhere; and
(ii.) That the animal so strayed or was so tethered through the malicious act of some person, for whose acts the owner is not responsible.

(1 B) Whenever any such animal shall be found so straying or so tethered, and it is proved that such animal so strayed or was so tethered by reason of the malicious act of some person, for whose acts the owner of the animal is not responsible, such person shall be guilty of an offence.

(1 C) This section shall only apply to such thoroughfares and within such limits as shall be notified by the Governor by Proclamation in that behalf.

(1 D) Provided that an animal belonging to a cart and tethered in a public thoroughfare while such cart is being loaded or unloaded shall not be deemed to be tethered without lawful right within the meaning of this section.

II.—Immediately after the words “two shillings,” wherever they occur, insert the words “or such other sum as the Governor in Executive Council, by notification in the ‘Government Gazette,’ may fix from time to time.”

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

To obtain a conviction under section 94 (1) of the principal Ordinance as it now stands against a person, it is necessary to prove a definite act, namely, that he either turned or suffered to be turned loose on any road or canal any of the animals named therein, or tied or tethered any such animal so that it could or should make its way into any road or canal. As the straying of cattle and other like animals is a grave nuisance and hindrance to the public, and as in most cases it is extremely difficult or almost impossible to prove such a definite act, this Ordinance constitutes the mere fact of any such animal being found straying or tethered upon any thoroughfare, or so tethered that it could make its way into any thoroughfare, an offence for which the owner is liable, unless he exculpates himself by proof that the animal was found straying or was so tethered through the malicious act of some person, for whose acts the owner is not responsible. This Ordinance also provides that if the owner succeeds in exculpating himself, the person whose act led to the animal straying or being tethered is guilty of an offence.

2. It is also provided that the Governor in Executive Council may from time to time prescribe what remuneration should be paid for the seizure of animals straying upon thoroughfares, because it has been felt that the sum of “two shillings” fixed by the principal Ordinance is not adequate remuneration in some districts.

2 In sub-section (1) of new section 27 A, added to the principal Ordinance by section 3 of “The Land Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 29 of 1917,” the words “or until” shall be omitted.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Ordinance is to give effect to a point to which attention has been drawn by the Secretary of State.

2. New section 27 A of the Land Registration Ordinance, added by the amending Ordinance of last year, is based upon an English model. The English model reads: "No *lis pendens*, &c., shall bind a purchaser, &c., unless and until the same shall be registered." By a misprint the phrase "unless and until" has in our own Ordinance been converted into "unless or until." It is pointed out that the result of substituting the word "or" for "and" is that when a *lis pendens* is registered after the purchase, &c., the purchaser, &c., will then become bound by it. But the use of the word "until" seems in any case out of place, as whether used with "or" or with "and" it seems to imply that the *lis pendens* may in some way bind the purchaser if registered after purchase. Under the circumstances, it is proposed to omit the words "or until" altogether.
