### Galle S. O. No. 380.

# Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kosgahahenadeniya, situate in the village of Udugama, in the Gangaboda pattu of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 29th day of June, 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Kosgahahenadeniya, situate in the village of Udugama, in the Gangaboda pattu of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 4 acres and 17 perches, and shown as lot 116 in preliminary plan 528 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Thomas Graham Willett, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,410):


