Kurunegala S. O. No. 2,259.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Wegollehena, situate in the village of Wennaruwa, in the Udukaha korele east of the Dambadeni hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 21st day of September, 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Wegollehena, situate in the village of Wennaruwa, in the Uduk ha korale east of the Dambadeni hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 2 acres 2 roods and 12 perches, and shown as lot 96k in preliminary plan 411 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Norman Albert Hampton, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown. and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,571):


