## VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE MONTH OF JUNE, 1918.

### REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

This report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-38 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

#### **Births.**

2. The number of births registered was 1,281 (625 males and 656 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 24·57 per 1,000, against 24·85 in the preceding month, 24·09 in the corresponding month of last year, and 26·08 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 8·85 in Nuwara Eliya to 66·80 in Mullaittivu. No births were registered in Va vuniya and Kalpitiya.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 417 (202 males and 215 females), and were equal to an annual rate\* of 18·34 per 1,000, against 19·28 in the preceding month, 17·49 in the corresponding month of last year, and 21·75 the average for the corresponding months since 1908. The rate ranged from 9·34 in Kollupitiya to 29·51 in Wellawatta.

#### **Deaths.**

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,306 (696 males and 610 females). There were 1,079 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 22·56 per 1,000, against 20·86 in the preceding month, 22·76 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·91 the average for the month of June in each year since 1908. The rate ranged from 200·43 in Nawalapitiya to 8·97 in Hatton and Dikoya. The abnormally high rate of Nawalapitiya is due to a large number of deaths from *Plague*.

5. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 459 (266 males and 193 females). There were 403 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual rate\* of 20·56 per 1,000, against 18·22 in the preceding month, 20·55 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·96 the average for the month of June in each year since 1908. The lowest rate, 7·09, was in Kollupitiya, and the highest, 19·33, in Kotahena.

6. The stillbirths registered numbered 79 (38 males and 41 females), against 87 in the preceding month.

#### **Infant Mortality.**

7. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 212 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending June 30, 1918. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 232, against 221 in the preceding month, 247 in the corresponding month of last year, and 260 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

8. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 235 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ending June 30, 1918. Calculated on the births registered during the month only the rate was 271, against 243 in the preceding month, 270 in the corresponding month of last year, and 311 the average for the corresponding months since 1908.

#### **Causes of Death.**

9. The highest mortality was attributed to *Pneumonia*, to which 11 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 9 per cent. was due to *Debility*, 7 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 6 per cent. to *Phthisis*, 4 per cent. each to *Diarrhoea*, *Enteritis*, and *Anchylostomiasis*, 3 per cent. each to *Malaria* and *Malarial Oachexia*, *Prematurity*, *Bright's Disease*, and *Nephritis*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Dysentery*, and 2 per cent. each to *Bronchitis* and *Puerperal Septicæmia*.

10. In Colombo too the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 13 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 10 per cent. was due to *Phthisis*, 8 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 6 per cent. to *Debility*, 5 per cent. to *Enteritis*, 4 per cent. to *Enteric Fever*, 3 per cent. each to *Bronchitis*, *Anchylostomiasis*, and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, 2 per cent. to *Diarrhoea*, and 1 per cent. each to *Tetanus* and *Puerperal Septicæmia*.

11. The number of deaths registered from *Plague* was 65 (57 in Nawalapitiya and 8 in Colombo), as against 9 in the preceding month and 3 in the corresponding month of last year. There were 11 deaths from *Smallpox* (7 in Mannar and 4 in Colombo).

12. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Smallpox*, of which 135 cases were reported (109 in Mannar and 26 in Colombo), followed by *Phthisis* 108 (95 in Colombo), *Chickenpox* 100 (83 in Colombo, 5 in Kandy), *Enteric Fever* 55 (40 in Colombo, 7 in Moratuwa), *Continued Fever* 48 (16 in Colombo, 14 in Moratuwa, 7 in Panadure, 5 in Kandy), *Measles* 42 (15 each in Colombo and Nuwara Eliya, 10 in Kandy), *Plague* 33 (24 in Nawalapitiya and 9 in Colombo), *Whooping Cough* 5 (in Colombo), *Dysentery* 4 (3 in Moratuwa), *Diphtheria* 2 (1 in Colombo and 1 in Kandy), and *Mumps* 2 (1 in Colombo and 1 in Jaffna).

#### **Meteorology.**

13. *Rainfall.*—Ratnapura recorded the highest rainfall (16·83 inches), followed by Hatton (16·26 inches). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 12·24 inches in Gampola to 0·08 of an inch in Puttalam. Colombo recorded 5·04 inches.

14. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 60·6° in Nuwara Eliya to 86·3° in Trincomalee, and was 81·8° in Colombo.
