Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Trade Marks (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 23 of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall by Proclamation appoint.

Substitution of new clause (c) for clause (c) of sub-section (4) of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 For clause (c) of sub-section (4) of section 2 of the principal Ordinance the following clause shall be substituted:
 - (c) No registration of a cotton mark, that is to say, a trade mark in respect of cotton piece goods or cotton yarn in classes 23 and 24 in schedule 3 of the rules made under section 40 (1) of the principal Ordinance, as amended by Ordinances Nos. 4 of 1890, 6 of 1904, and 9 of 1906, dated June 1, 1906, and published in the Government Gazette of June 1, 1906, shall give any exclusive right to the use of any word, letter, numeral, line heading, or any combination thereof.

An Ordinance to amend "The Forest Ordinance, 1907."

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Forest Ordinance, 1907": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Forest (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 24 of 1918," and shall come into operation on the passing hereof.

Addition of new section to principal Ordinance.

Power to shoot cattle on forest plantation.

2 The following new section shall be inserted immediately after section 55 of the principal Ordinance:

55 A. If it shall be shown to the satisfaction of any Government Agent or Assistant Government Agent that cattle are in the habit of trespassing on any forest plantation situated wholly or in part within his province or district and cannot be seized, it shall be lawful for him to authorize, by license in writing under his hand, some fit person or persons to proceed to such plantation, and if after reasonable exertion such person shall find it impracticable to seize such animals, to shoot or otherwise destroy the same, or cause the same to be shot or otherwise destroyed in his presence, and this notwithstanding that in the endeavour to seize such animals they may have been driven off such plantation. Provided that such license shall not be subject to any stamp duty, and shall not be in force for more than one month from the date thereof.
