MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Road Ordinance, 1861": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

Amendment of section 91 of principal Ordinance. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Road (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

2 In section 94 of the principal Ordinance-

I.—For the clause beginning "(1) Whoseever shall turn or suffer to be turned loose " in line 4, and ending " unloading of any cart or boat to which it may belong " in line 11, there shall be substituted the following :

(1) Whoever shall turn or suffer to be turned loose any ox, buffalo, horse, sheep, or goat on any thoroughfare or so that it strays on any thoroughfare, or shall tie or tether any ox, buffalo, horse, or other animal of any description so that any such animal can or shall make its way into any thoroughfare, unless such animal shall be so tied or tethered during the time required when loading or unloading it or for the loading or unloading of any cart or boat to which it may belong. Provided that where any such animal is found loose on any thoroughfare or tethered in such a way that it can make its way into any thoroughfare, such animal shall be deemed to have been turned loose, or suffered to be turned loose, or to have been tied or tethered, as the case may be, by the owner thereof, unless he satisfies the court to the contrary.

II.—Immediately after the words "two shillings," wherever they occur, insert the words "or such other sum as the Governor in Executive Council, by notification in the 'Government Gazette,' may fix from time to time."

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

To obtain a conviction under section 94 (1) of the principal Ordinance as it now stands against a person, it is necessary to prove a definite act, namely, that he either turned or suffered to be turned loose on any road or canal any of the animals named therein, or tied or tethered any such animal so that it could or should make its way into any road or canal. As the straying of cattle and other like animals is a grave nuisance and hindrance to the public, and as in most cases it is extremely difficult or almost impossible to prove such a definite act, this Ordinance constitutes the mere fact of any such animal being found straying or tethered upon any thoroughfare, or so tethered that it could make its way into any thoroughfare, an offence for which the owner is liable, unless he exculpates himself by proof that the animal was found straying or was so tethered through the malicious act of some person, for whose acts the owner is not responsible. This Ordinance also provides that if the owner succeeds in exculpating himself, the person whose act led to the animal straying or being tethered is guilty of an offence.

2. It is also provided that the Governor in Executive Council may from time to time prescribe what remuneration should be paid for the seizure of animals straying upon thoroughfares, because it has been felt that the sum of "two shillings" fixed by the principal Ordinance is not adequate remuneration in some districts.




