#### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

#### An Ordinance further to amend "The Mines and Machinery Protection Ordinance, 1896."

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Mines and Machinery Protection Ordinance, 1896": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Mines and Machinery Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1918."

Addition of new paragraph to section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

2 The following paragraph shall be added to section 4 of the principal Ordinance, after paragraph (h), the subsequent paragraph being lettered accordingly :

(i) The holding of inquiries and investigations with respect to such accidents or mishaps, the enforcement of the attendance of witnesses thereat, and the production of papers, the persons by whom the costs of such inquiries and investigations are to be paid, and the manner of enforcing such payment.

Amendment of section 6.

3 The following amendments shall be made in section 6 of the principal Ordinance :

- (a) In line 16, for the words "an offence," there shall be inserted the words "a summary offence";
- (b) In line 17, for the word "fifty," there shall be inserted the words "five hundred"; and
- (c) In line 20, for the word "hundred," there shall be inserted the word "thousand."

Amendment of section 7.

4 In the final line of section 7 of the principal Ordinance, for the words "six months," there shall be inserted the words "one year."

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

A RECENT boiler accident, at which six persons were killed and one injured, has drawn attention to the fact that our Ordinance for the protection of mines and machinery makes no provision (such as exists in the United Kingdom) for inquiries into accidents by expert officers. This defect is remedied by the addition of a paragraph to section 4, authorizing the holding of inquiries and investigations on the same lines as those in England with respect to accidents in connection with mines, machinery, and boilers under the Coal Mines Regulation Act, 1887, the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, and the Boiler Explosion Act, 1882.

2. Advantage has also been taken to increase the fine which may be imposed for a breach of any of the rules under this Ordinance from Rs. 50 to Rs. 500 in the case of a first offence, and from Rs. 100 to Rs. 1,000 in the case of subsequent convictions, the existing fines having, from experience, been found to be not sufficiently deterrent. Power is also given to Police Courts to try offences under this Ordinance summarily.

3. Lastly, the period within which prosecutions are barred is extended from six months to one year. Experience has proved that six months is too short a period, and that, consequently, offences have in some cases escaped punishment.
