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#### FINAL ORDERS.

#### Matale S. O. No. 34.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Hunugalpitiyayaya, Hunugalpitiya (reservation for path), Tawalampitiyeyaya, &c., situate in the village of Narangomuwa, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale South division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1906, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 1st day of December, 1916, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Hunugalpitiyayaya, Hunugalpitiya (reservation for path), Tawalampitiyeyaya, &c., situate in the village of Narangomuwa, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale South division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, containing in extent 251 acres 1 rood and 1 perch, and shown as lots 2, 2A, 14, 14A, 14B, 14C, 14E, 33, 40, 43, 46, 55, 78J, 78L, 80I, 80J, 78C, 78D, 78E, 78, 78N, 80E, 80F, 80, 101, 135, 137, and 2E in block survey preliminary plan 24, and in the annexed diagrams, was made to John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,090):


