Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1908."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Dehigahamulaheneyaya and Keppettiyayahena, situate in the village of Madawela, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale south division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
