### PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 9 of 1919.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907"; Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as "The Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 9 of 1919;" and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, appoint.

- Amendment of section 3 of the principal Ordinance.**      2 Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end of the definition of "animal" the words "and includes any bird, fish, or reptile in captivity."
- Substitution of new section 4.**      3 For section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following section shall be substituted :
- Cruelty defined.**      4. (1) Any person who shall—
- (a) Cruelly beat, ill-treat, over-drive, over-ride, abuse, or torture, or cause or procure to be cruelly beaten, ill-treated, over-driven, over-ridden, abused, or tortured, any animal ;
- (b) By any act or omission cause unnecessary pain or suffering to any animal ; or
- (c) Convey or carry, or cause to be conveyed or carried, in any ship, boat, canoe, or in any vehicle, basket, box, or cage, or otherwise, any animal in such manner or position as to subject such animal to unnecessary pain or suffering—
- Penalty.**      shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be punished with a fine which may extend to one hundred rupees, or with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to three months, or with both.
- (2) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council to make rules as to the manner of keeping and treatment of animals.
- (3) If any person contravenes any such rule, he shall be deemed for all purposes to have caused unnecessary pain or suffering to such animals.
- Addition of new section 4 A.**      4 The following section shall be added immediately after section 4 of the principal Ordinance, and shall be numbered 4 A :
- 4 A. If any animal is found in any place suffering pain by reason of starvation, mutilation, or other ill-treatment, the owner of such animal, and any superintendent or manager of such owner, shall severally be guilty of an offence, and shall be punished with a fine which may extend to one hundred rupees, and in the case of a second or subsequent offence, with a fine which may extend to two hundred rupees, or with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to three months, or with both.
- Provided, however, that it shall be a good defence to any such charge if the owner of such animal, or if any such superintendent or manager, proves to the satisfaction of the court that the condition of the animal was not due to any act, omission, neglect, or default on his part.
- Amendment of section 6 of principal Ordinance.**      5 Section 6 of the principal Ordinance shall be amended by the substitution of the words "or with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to three months, or with both," for the words "or in default to imprisonment of either description which may extend to three months."

**An Ordinance further to amend "The Stamp Ordinance, 1909."**

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Stamp Ordinance, 1909": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Stamp (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 10 of 1919," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, appoint.

Substitution of new schedule B.

2 For schedule B of the principal Ordinance, as the same is set out in section 7 of "The Stamp (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 16 of 1917," there shall be substituted the following:

## An Ordinance further to amend "The Land Registration Ordinance, 1891."

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Land Registration Ordinance, 1891": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title and date of coming into operation.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Land Registration (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1919," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the *Government Gazette*, appoint.

Substitution of new schedules III. and V.

2 Schedules III. and V. of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance in lieu thereof :
