**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE  
MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1919.**

REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

**Births.**

2. The number of births registered was 1,421 (735 males and 686 females), and was equivalent to an annual rate of 26·62 per 1,000, against 25·65 in the preceding month, 26·93 in the corresponding month of last year, and 29·62 the average for the corresponding months since 1909. The rate ranged from 8·30 in Mullaittivu to 57·27 in Kalmunai.

3. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 484 (245 males and 239 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 20·60 per 1,000, against 19·82 in the preceding month, 22·65 in the corresponding month of last year, and 24·97 the average for the corresponding months since 1909. The rate ranged from 6·71 in Kollupitiya to 26·38 in Wellawatta.

**Deaths.**

4. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,831 (1,070 males and 761 females). There were 1,415 deaths of residents in towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 28·89 per 1,000, against 23·42 in the preceding month, 41·24 in the corresponding month of the previous year, and 30·57 the average for the month of November in each year since 1909. The rate ranged from 45·59 in Moratuwa to 10·08 in Nuwara Eliya.

5. In the city of Colombo the deaths numbered 748 (463 males and 285 females). There were 627 deaths of residents, equivalent to an annual rate of 30·98 per 1,000, against 21·98 in the preceding month, 35·56 in the corresponding month of last year, and 29·89 the average for the month of November in each year since 1909. The rate ranged from 29·57 in St. Paul's to 8·24 in Kollupitiya.

6. The stillbirths registered numbered 77 (41 males and 36 females), as against 87 in the preceding month.

**Infant Mortality.**

7. The mortality of infants under one year of age was equal to a rate of 284 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November 30, 1919. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 270, against 194 in the preceding month, 339 in the corresponding month of last year, and 239 the average for the corresponding months since 1909.

8. In the city of Colombo the mortality of infants was equal to a rate of 291 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November 30, 1919. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 291, against 190 in the preceding month, 336 in the corresponding month of last year, and 297 the average for the corresponding months since 1909.

**Causes of Death.**

9. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 10 per cent. of the total deaths was due, 9 per cent. was due to *Debility*, 7 per cent. each to *Convulsions* and *Diarrhœa*, 6 per cent. each to *Phthisis* and *Anchylostomiasis*, 5 per cent. to *Dysentery*, 4 per cent. to *Enteritis*, 3 per cent. each to *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, and 2 per cent. each to *Influenza*, *Bronchitis*, and *Prematurity*.

10. In Colombo, too, the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 12 per cent. of the deaths was due, 8 per cent. was due to *Phthisis*, 7 per cent. to *Debility*, 6 per cent. to *Convulsions*, 5 per cent. each to *Enteric Fever*, *Enteritis*, and *Diarrhœa*, 4 per cent. each to *Influenza* and *Plague*, 3 per cent. each to *Dysentery*, *Bronchitis*, and *Anchylostomiasis*, and 2 per cent. each to *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis* and *Prematurity*.

11. Thirty deaths from *Plague* were registered (in Colombo), as against 17 in the preceding month and 2 in the corresponding month of last year. The number registered from this cause during the month alone exceed the total number registered during the previous ten months of the year. There were registered 4 deaths from *Cholera* in Badulla, and 3 from *Measles* in Colombo.

12. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phthisis*, of which 138 cases were reported (127 in Colombo, 109 (98 in Colombo, 7 in Kandy), *Chickenpox* 94 (74 in Colombo, 11 in Nuwara Eliya), *Enteric Fever* 78 (64 in Colombo, 5 in Kandy), *Plague* 34 (in Colombo), *Continued Fever* 29 (18 in Colombo, 7 in Kandy), *Mumps* 8 (4 in Colombo, 3 in Kandy), *Acute Diarrhœa* 3 (in Batticaloa), *Dysentery* 3 (in Kurunagala,) *Whooping Cough* 1 (in Colombo), and *Cholera* 1 (in Badulla).

**Meteorology.**

13. *Rainfall.*—Nawalapitiya recorded the highest rainfall (21·90 inches), followed by Kegalla (21·14 inches). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 21·01 inches in Gampola to 3·38 inches in Hambantota. Colombo recorded 8·89 inches.

14. *Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 59·2° in Nuwara Eliya to 80·8° in Mannar and Trincomalee respectively, and was 79·6° in Colombo.
