Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kerawalawatta, situate in the village of Lulbadduwa, in the Walallawiti pattu of the Pasdun korale west of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."




In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Mailagahawatta, situate in the village of Lulbadduwa, in the Walallawiti pattu of the Pasdun korale west of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
