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FINAL ORDERS.

Kalutara S. O. No. 43.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kerawalawatta, situate in the village of Lulbadduwa, in the Walallawiti pattu of the Pasdun korale west of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 22nd day of June, 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Kerawalawatta, situate in the village of Lulbadduwa, in the Walallawiti pattu of the Pasdun korale west of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, containing in extent 1 acre 2 roods and 1 perch, and shown as lot 39 in preliminary plan 80, and in the annexed diagram, was made to Thomas Arthur Hodson, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 6,401):

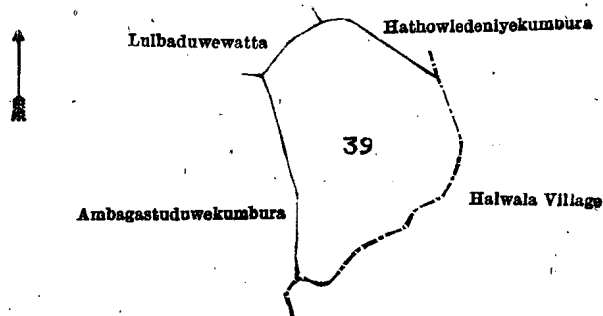
