IN the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland and of the British Dominions beyond the Seas, King, Defender of the Faith.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir WILLIAM HENRY MANNING, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Companion of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof.

WHEREAS in pursuance of "The Trading with the Enemy (Amendment No. 2) Ordinance, No. 13 of 1916," by Our Proclamation published in the *Government Gazette* of August 2, 1918, We did publish the Royal Proclamation dated May 23, 1916, with the Statutory List as revised of persons or bodies of persons with whom trading was prohibited :

And whereas by Our subsequent Proclamations We did from time to time publish further amendments of the said Statutory List :

And whereas it has been decided to withdraw all Statutory Lists as from midnight, April 28, 1919, and instructions have been sent to this effect to the Ceylon Government :

Now know Ye that We, the Governor of Ceylon, do hereby notify for general information that the said Statutory Lists and amendments thereof from time to time published will be withdrawn as and from midnight, April 28, 1919.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Twenty-eighth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Nineteen.
