Regulations made by the Governor under the provisions of the Order of Her Majesty in Council dated October 26, 1896, as amended by the Order of His Majesty in Council dated March 21, 1916, and of all other Powers him enabling.

- 1. Regulation 1 of the regulations made by the Governor on November 28, 1918, and December 3, 1918, with reference to the removal and transport of rice from the Southern Province, and published in the Government Gazette Extraordinary of November 30, 1918, and December 3, 1918, is further amended by inserting the words "or paddy" after "rice" in the first line thereof.
 - 2. This regulation shall come into operation on and after June 24, 1919.

Regulations made by the Governor under the provisions of the Order of Her Majesty in Council dated October 26, 1896, as amended by the Order of His Majesty in Council dated March 21, 1916, and of all other Powers him enabling.

- 1. From and after the commencement of these regulations it is forbidden to remove or transport paddy, by any means, from the division of Udapalata, in the District of Kandy, Central Province, except under permit to be issued by the Government Agent of the Province.
- 2. Any person who contravenes the provisions of the last preceding regulation shall be guilty of an offence, and shall be liable on summary conviction to imprisonment of either description for any term not exceeding six months, or to a fine not exceeding Rs. 1,500, or to both.
 - 3. These regulations shall commence and come into operation on June 24, 1919.
