#### GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS

Regulations made by the Governor under the provisions of the Order in Council of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria dated October 26, 1896, as amended by the Order in Council of His Majesty dated March 21, 1916, and of all other Powers him enabling.

REGULATION 1 B of "The Defence of the Colony Regulations, 1919," published in the Government Gazette of June 21, 1919, is amended as follows:—

- 1. In line 3 of regulation 1 B (1), for the word "rice" there shall be substituted the words "foodstuff that may be specified in such order."
- 2. Save as aforesaid, wherever the word "rice" occurs in the said regulation there shall be substituted for the word "rice" the words "such foodstuff."

#### MAXIMUM PRICES FOR FLOUR IN COLOMBO.

Order made by the Food Controller under Regulation 1 of "The Defence of the Colony Regulations, 1919," fixing the Prices at which Flour may be sold in Colombo.

- 1. No grade or brand of flour shall be sold or offered for sale in Colombo at a price exceeding that set forth in the schedule to this order in respect of each such grade or brand of flour.
  - 2. This order shall commence and come into operation on July 1, 1919.
