Galle S. O. No. 393.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Lands to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Peellaihalagodella, &c., situate in the village of Mapalagama, in the Gangaboda pattu of the Galle District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 26th day of July, 1918, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Peellaihalagodella, &c., situate in the village of Mapalagama, in the Gangaboda pattu of the Gelle District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 319 acres and 1 perch, and shown as lots 220 and 220x in block survey preliminary plan 526 and in the annexed diagrams, was made to Arnold Langdon Crossman, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6.974):
