PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 12 of 1919.

An Ordinance for making provision for the Contingent Services for the Financial Year October, 1919, to September, 1920.

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the contingent expenditure required for the service of the Government of this Island for the financial year October, 1919, to September, 1920, and not otherwise provided for, has been estimated at the sum of Seventy-four million Eight hundred and Twenty-six thousand Five hundred and Fifty-six rupees: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 74,826,556 to be charged upon the revenue of this Island for the Contingent Services for the financial year October, 1919, to September, 1920.

1 A sum not exceeding Seventy-four million Eight hundred and Twenty-six thousand Five hundred and Fifty-six rupees shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of this Island for the Contingent Services for the financial year October, 1919, to September, 1920, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the Heads of Expenditure specified in the schedule hereunto annexed.

Amount of labour to be supplied under the Ordinance No. 31 of 1884.

2 And whereas by the 31st section of the Ordinance No. 31 of the year 1884, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 10 of 1861, entitled 'An Ordinance to consolidate and amend the Laws relating to Public Thoroughfares in this Colony,'" it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to propose the estimates prepared in pursuance thereof, or such of them as to him may appear expedient, in the Ordinance for making provision for the contingent expenditure of the Colony for the ensuing year, to be dealt with in like manner as any other estimate to be so proposed: And it is thereby also provided that the amount of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance No. 31 of 1884, for the performance of any work or works for which an estimate or estimates may have been so proposed by the Governor, and approved of by the Legislative Council, shall be distinctly stated in the Ordinance enacted for the same, and that the same shall not exceed two-thirds of the whole amount of labour due from the district or districts within which it may be required to be performed: It is enacted that the amount

of labour to be supplied under the provisions of the said Ordinance shall be in conformity with the estimates detailed under Head No. 40, "Public Works Annually Recurrent."

Treasurer to pay the above at such times as the Governor by warrant shall order.

3 The Treasurer of the said Island shall issue and pay the said several sums to such persons, for the purposes hereinbefore mentioned, upon such days and in such proportions as the Governor for the time being, by any warrant or order in writing to be signed by him, shall from time to time order and direct; and the payments so to be made shall be charged upon and payable out of the revenues and other funds of the said Island.

And to receive credit to his accounts for the payments made in pursuance hereof.

4 The said Treasurer shall in his accounts from time to time be allowed credit for any sum or sums of money paid by him in pursuance of such warrant or order in writing as aforesaid; and the receipt or receipts of the respective persons to whom the same shall be so paid shall be a full and valid discharge to the said Treasurer in passing his said accounts for any such sum or sums as shall be herein mentioned; and he shall and may receive credit for the same accordingly.

No. 13 of 1919.

An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1917-18.

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 19 of 1917 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Sixty-five million Four hundred and Thirty-five thousand Six hundred and Sixteen rupees should be charged upon the revenue and other funds of this Island for the Contingent Service of the financial year 1917-18, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said period: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 4,962,085·89 to be charged upon the revenue of the Island for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1917-18.

1 That a sum not exceeding Four million Nine hundred and Sixty-two thousand and Eighty-five rupees and Eighty-nine cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of the Colony for the services hereinafter mentioned, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed:

No. 14 of 1919.

An Ordinance to amend "The Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance, 1897."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases Ordinance, 1897": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Quarantine and Prevention of Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 14 of 1919."

Amendment of the preamble of the principal Ordinance.

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

2 In line 5 of the preamble to the principal Ordinance, immediately after the words "such diseases in," there shall be added the words "and outside."

3 At the end of section 4 of the principal Ordinance, and in continuation thereof, there shall be inserted the words "in and outside the Island."

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 15 of 1919.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Buddhist Temporalities Ordinance, 1905."

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Buddhist Temporalities Ordinance, 1905": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Buddhist Temporalities (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 15 of 1919."

Substitution of new sections 15 and 16.

2 Sections 15 and 16 of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed, and the following sections shall be inserted in lieu thereof:

Governor to appoint one or more Commissioners.

15. (1) It shall be lawful for the Governor, by Proclamation published in the "Government Gazette," to appoint one or more Commissioners for the purpose of controlling and assisting district committees in the administration and management of the funds and property of their temples, and for the purpose of exercising the powers by the next succeeding section assigned to a Commissioner.

(2) The Governor may invest any Commissioner with all or any of the powers set forth in Ordinance No. 9 of 1872.

(3) Each such Commissioner shall exercise the powers by this section conferred with respect to all district committees elected for districts situated within the area defined in the Proclamation appointing him as aforesaid.

When district committee may suspend trustee.

16. (1) A district committee shall, whenever it shall be made apparent, to them by evidence which they shall duly record, that any trustee has been guilty of gross negligence or misconduct, suspend such trustee, and forthwith report such suspension and transmit such evidence to the Commissioner, if any, appointed for the area within which the district of such district committee is situated, and such Commissioner shall have power to dismiss such trustee and cause another to be elected in his stead as provided in section 17.

Commissioner may dismiss such trustee and elect another.

When no Commissioner, district committee may dismiss such trustee.

(2) If no Commissioner has been appointed to whom a district committee can report as in the last preceding sub-section mentioned, the district committee may dismiss such trustee and cause another to be elected in his place.

Decision final.

Proviso.

(3) The decision of the Commissioner or of the district committee, as the case may be, in regard to such dismissal shall be final and conclusive. Provided always that before such suspension or dismissal the trustee who shall be suspended or dismissed shall be called upon to answer specific charges which shall be formulated against him, and be allowed an opportunity of defending himself.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 16 of 1919.

An Ordinance to amend "The Lunacy Ordinance, 1873."

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Lunacy Ordinance, 1873": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance shall be cited as "The Lunacy (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 16 of 1919."

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

2 There shall be added as paragraph (3) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance the following paragraph:

(3) "Criminal lunatic" means any of the following persons:

(a) Any person who is confined or continued in confinement in a lunatic asylum under the provisions of section 12 or section 13 of this Ordinance; and

(b) Any person who is ordered by the Governor to be confined in a lunatic asylum under the provisions of section 369 (2) or section 374 of "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."

Addition of new sections 19, 20, and 21.

3 The following new sections shall be added to the principal Ordinance at the end thereof, and numbered 19, 20, and 21, respectively:

Recapture of lunatics generally.

19. (1) If any person detained in a lunatic asylum under the provisions of this Ordinance, and not being a criminal lunatic, escapes, he may be re-taken at any time within fourteen days of his escape by the Superintendent of the asylum, or by any officer or servant thereof, or by any one authorized in writing by such Superintendent, and conveyed to, received, and detained in such asylum.

(2) In the case of the escape of a criminal lunatic, the provisions of the last preceding sub-section shall apply without any limitation as to time.

Recapture of lunatic, not being a criminal lunatic, after fourteen days.

20. In any case in which a person detained in a lunatic asylum, and not being a criminal lunatic, has escaped, and is not taken within the period of fourteen days prescribed by the last preceding section, the Superintendent of such asylum may apply to the District Judge within the limits of whose jurisdiction such asylum is situated, for authority to re-take such person. If the District Judge to whom such application is made shall, after making such inquiry, if any, as he may deem necessary, grant such authority, such Superintendent or any one authorized in writing by him may re-take such person, and such person may be conveyed to, received, and detained in the asylum.

Absence on trial.

21. (1) The Governor may, on the recommendation in writing of the Superintendent of an asylum, permit, by order under his hand, any person detained in a lunatic asylum, and not being a criminal lunatic, to be absent on trial for a period to be named in such order.

(2) If at any time within the period mentioned in such order it appears to such Superintendent that the further detention of such person in the asylum is necessary, such Superintendent, or any person authorized by him in writing, may take such person, and such person may thereupon be conveyed to, received, and detained in the asylum.

(3) (a) At the expiration of the period mentioned in any such order, such person shall, unless he has been received into the asylum under the provisions of the last preceding sub-section, return to the asylum, and the Superintendent shall examine him, and may thereupon either direct his further detention in the asylum, or order him to be discharged.

(b) If such person does not return to the asylum at the expiration of the period for which he was allowed to be absent on trial, he may at any time within fourteen days of the expiration of the period of trial be re-taken, as in the case of an escape.
