An Ordinance to make provision for determining the Date of the Termination of the present War, and for purposes connected therewith.

W. H. MANNING.

HEREAS it is expedient to make provision for determining the date of the termination of the present war, and for purposes connected therewith : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

This Ordinance may be cited as "The Termination of the Present War (Definition) Ordinance, No. 17 of 1919."

2 (1) The present war shall, for the purposes of any provision in any Ordinance, rule, regulation, Order in Council or Proclamation, and, except where the context otherwise requires, of any provision in any contract, deed, or other instrument referring, expressly or impliedly, and in whatever form of words, to the present war or the present hostilities, be treated as having continued to and as having ended on such date as it is declared by His Majesty in Council, under the provisions of the Termination of the Present War (Definition) Act, 1918, of the Imperial Parliament, shall be treated as the date of the termination of the present war.

(2) In the event of His Majesty in Council declaring under the provisions of the said Act that any date shall be treated as the date of the termination of war between His Majesty and any particular State, a similar effect shall, as regards such State, be given to such declaration.

) A copy of the Government Gazette containing a Proclamation by the Governor in Executive Council that any such date has been declared by His Majesty in Council shall be evidence in all courts and for all purposes of such date having been declared as aforesaid.







HEREAS it is expedient to regulate admission into, and expulsion from, the Colony of former enemy aliens : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

may, without prejudice to any other liability imposed by this Ordinance, be ordered by the Governor, in his absolute diseretion, to quit the Colony within a time to be named in such order, and if such former enemy alien or person refuses or neglects to obey such order, the Governor may cause him to be arrested with a view to his removal from the Colony, and for that purpose to be detained in custody and to be placed on board any ship or boat.

(2) No court of law shall have any jurisdiction to question the exercise of any such discretion on any grounds whatsoever.

7 The onus of proving in any proceedings under this Ordinance that a person alleged to be a former enemy alien is not a former enemy alien, or that he has obtained the permission of the Colonial Secretary to land, shall be upon such person.

8 This Ordinance shall remain in force for three years from the date of the same receiving the assent of the Governor.
