DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend "The Estate Duty Ordinance, No. 8 of 1919."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Estate Duty Ordinance, No. 8 of 1919" : Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Estate Duty (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1919."

Insertion of new section 17 A in principal Ordinance.

2 The following shall be inserted as section 17 A of the principal Ordinance :

Mode of determining local situation of property in the United Kingdom.

17 A. The local situation in the United Kingdom of any property shall be determined in accordance with the law of England with regard to the local situation of property within the meaning of section 20 of the Finance Act, 1894, of the Imperial Parliament.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 20 of the Finance Act, 1894, provides that where the Commissioners of Inland Revenue in England are satisfied that in a British Possession to which that section applies duty is payable by reason of a death in respect of any property situate in such Possession and passing on such death, the Commissioners are to allow a sum equal to the amount of that duty to be deducted from the estate duty payable in respect of that property on the same death.

2. The condition on which that section is made applicable to any particular British Possession depends upon the making of an Order in Council applying that section to the British Possession; but before that application can be made His Majesty in Council must be satisfied that by the law of that Possession either no duty is leviable in respect of property situate in the United Kingdom, or that the law of such Possession as respects any duty so leviable is to the like effect as the provisions of that section.

3. The Secretary of State has pointed out that it is not made absolutely clear in the Estate Duty Ordinance, No. 8 of 1919, that the local situation of property in the United Kingdom is to be decided according to the law of England, and has requested that this matter be dealt with. The object of this Bill is to satisfy the requirements of the Secretary of State.

DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend "The Vehicles Ordinance, No. 4 of 1916."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Vehicles Ordinance, No. 4 of 1916": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Vehicles (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1919," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the "Government Gazette," appoint.

Additions of
new paragraphs
to section 18 (2).

2 After paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 18 of the principal Ordinance the following paragraphs shall be added :

(a 1) For marking from time to time on the hoof or otherwise such animals as are to be used, and as are, in the opinion of the proper authority, fit to draw vehicles, and for the obliteration of any such marks in the case of animals ceasing, in the opinion of the proper authority or of any convicting court, to be fit to draw vehicles.

(a 2) For preventing the use of any animals not marked as aforesaid, or whose marks have been obliterated as aforesaid, to draw vehicles.

Amendment of
section 52.

3 The following proviso shall be added at the end of section 52 of the principal Ordinance :

Provided that in the case of a breach of any by-law made under section 22 of this Ordinance requiring the reporting of changes of ownership or of changes in description of mechanically propelled vehicles or changes of the postal addresses of owners, a prosecution in respect of any such breach may be commenced at any time within twelve months of the commission of any such breach.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THIS Ordinance is introduced at the request of the Ceylon Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals. It has been found from experience that horses are used for the purpose of drawing vehicles which were not passed by the proper authority, or which have become unfit for the purpose of drawing vehicles. The Draft Ordinance introduces an amendment, under which rules can be made prohibiting the use of horses, amongst other animals, to draw vehicles, unless the hoofs of such horses are marked by the proper authority; and also for the obliteration of such marks when horses become unfit for the purpose, either in the opinion of the proper authority or of a convicting court.

Section 52 of "The Vehicles Ordinance, No. 4 of 1916," provides that no prosecution shall be commenced except within three months of the commission of the offence. It has been found by the Police in practice that this period is too short in the cases dealt with in section 3 of this Bill, and it is proposed to extend the period of limitation to twelve months.

No. 20 of 1919.

An Ordinance to prevent Abuse of the Process of the Courts by the Institution of Vexatious Civil Legal Proceedings.

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to prevent a abuse of the process of the courts by the institution of vexatious legal proceedings: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Vexatious Actions Ordinance, No. 20 of 1919."

Power of
Supreme Court
to prohibit
institution
of action
without leave.

2 (1) It shall be lawful for the Attorney-General to apply to the Supreme Court or a Judge thereof for an order under this Ordinance, and if he satisfies such Court or Judge that any person has habitually and persistently instituted vexatious civil legal proceedings without any reasonable ground for instituting such proceedings in any court, and whether against the same person or against different persons, such Court or Judge may, after hearing such person or giving him an opportunity of being heard after assigning counsel in case such person is unable on account of poverty to retain counsel, order that no civil legal proceeding shall be instituted by that person in any court unless he obtains the leave of the Supreme Court or a Judge thereof, and satisfies the Court or Judge that such legal proceeding is not an abuse of the process of the Court, and that there is *prima facie* ground for such proceeding.

(2) A copy of such order shall be published in the *Government Gazette*.
