Order No. 63 made by the Food Controller under Regulation 1 of "The Defence of the Colony Regulations, 1919."

1. The order made by the Food Controller fixing the maximum price of Australian flour, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 7,029 of July 1, 1919, and order No. 47 made by the Food Controller, published in *Ceylon Government Gazette* No. 7,077 of January 16, 1920, are hereby cancelled as from the date of commencement of this order.

2. From and after the date of commencement of this order, no flour of the kinds or brands shown in the attached schedule shall be sold or offered for sale in Colombo at a price exceeding that shown in the schedule for each kind or brand.

3. This order shall commence and come into operation on April 7, 1920.
