PASSED ORDINANCES.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 29 of 1919.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1861."

W. H. MANNING.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1861": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Joint Stock Companies (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 29 of 1919."

Amendment of section 111 of the principal Ordinance.

2 The following provisos shall be added at the end of sub-section (3) of section 111 of the principal Ordinance (as set forth in section 5 of "The Joint Stock Companies (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 7 of 1918"):

Provided that the Registrar may, if he thinks fit, instead of instituting proceedings against such company or party in default, accept from such company or party such sum of money as the Registrar may think proper in composition of the offence committed by such company or party.

Provided further that when the Registrar has accepted any such sum of money as aforesaid, proceedings under this section shall not be taken, or if already taken shall not be continued, in respect of such offence against the company or party so compounding.

No. 30 of 1919.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Insect Pest and Quarantine Ordinance, No. 5 of 1901."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Insect Pest and Quarantine Ordinance, No. 5 of 1901"; Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Insect Pest and Quarantine (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 30 of 1919."

Substitution of new clause for clause (c) of section 4 (1) of principal Ordinance.

2 Sub-section (1) (c) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance shall be struck out and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:

(c) For cleansing or disinfecting by the Director of Agriculture or any person authorized thereto by him, and if expedient destroying, without compensation, all plants, or the packages, cases, pots, or coverings in which they may be packed, which shall be found or suspected to be infected with any insect or fungus or plant disease, and for the recovery of such fees as may be prescribed from the consignee.
