### PASSED ORDINANCE.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 12 of 1920.

An Ordinance for making provision for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the Year 1918-19.

GRAEME THOMSON.

Preamble.

WHEREAS by Ordinance No. 17 of 1918 it was enacted that a sum not exceeding Fifty-eight million Nine hundred and Fifty thousand Eight hundred and Ninety-two rupees should be charged upon the revenue and other funds of this Island for the Contingent Service of the financial year 1918-19, and it has become necessary to make further provision for the service of the said period: It is enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Rs. 12,804,443.59 to be charged upon the revenue of the Island for the Supplementary Contingent Charges for the year 1918-19.

1 That a sum not exceeding Twelve million Eight hundred and Four thousand Four hundred and Forty-three rupees and Fifty-nine cents shall be and the same is hereby charged upon the revenue and other funds of the Colony for the services hereinafter mentioned, and the said expenditure shall be in conformity with the Heads of Expenditure specified in the Schedule hereunto annexed:
