GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

ORDINANCE No. 13 OF 1896.

An Ordinance relating to Pilgrimages.

REGULATIONS made by His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under the powers committed to him by section 1 of Ordinance No. 13 of 1896 :—

1. The number of persons who shall be allowed to proceed on pilgrimage to Kataragama for the Ilmahā Kachchi festival in 1919 shall be restricted to five persons.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to proceed to Kataragama for the aforesaid festival—
 - (a) Except *viâ* Hambantota; and
 - (b) Unless he has first obtained a permit for the purpose from the Government Agent of the Southern Province.
3. No person authorized as aforesaid to attend the aforesaid festival shall stay at Kataragama for more than three days.
