Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," admitting Land to be Private Property.


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as high and low waste land, situate in the Uppukulam division of Mannar town of Mannar East, in Mannar island in Mannar District of the Northern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 17th day of August; 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as high and low waste land, situate in the Uppukulam division of of Mannar town of Mannar East, in Mannar island in Mannar District of the Nothern Province, containing in extent 2 acres and 2 perches, and shown as lot 128s in the plan of Uppukulam division of the Mannar town survey and in the annexed diagram, was made to John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,506):

And whereas (1) James Nicholas Michael Chelvanayagam, on behalf of his father (2) Simon Santiagoppillai Chelvanayagam, made claim thereto, and John Murray Davies and Frederick Lewis. Special Officers appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim, and whereas the said claimants entered into two agreements in writing dated the 24th day of July, 1919, whereby it was agreed that the said 1st claimant should be declared the owner of the said land, 1, Howard Orine Fox, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, do hereby, in pursuance of the said agreements dated July 24, 1919, admit the claim of the said 1st claimant to the said land, as more fully described herein below, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances.






