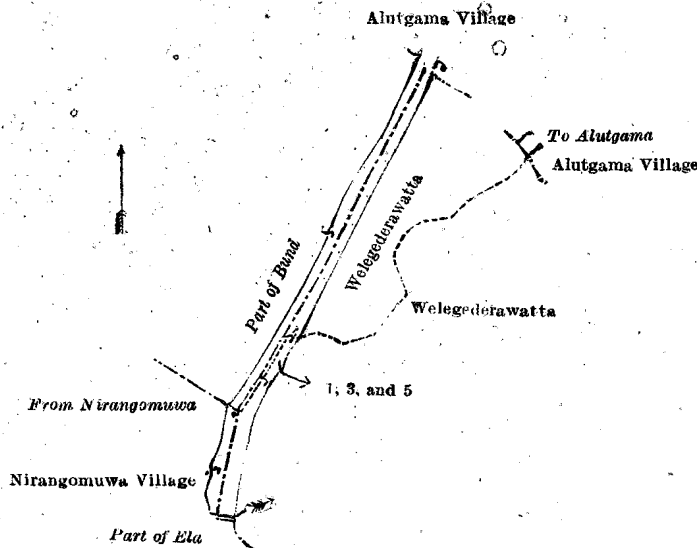

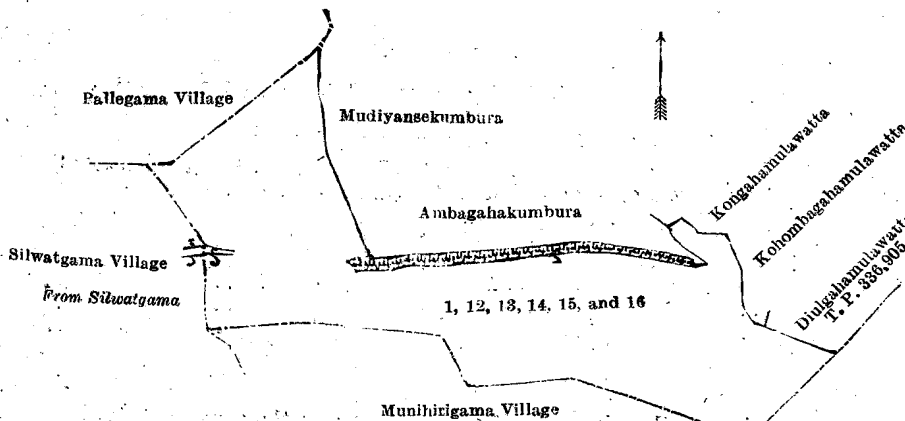

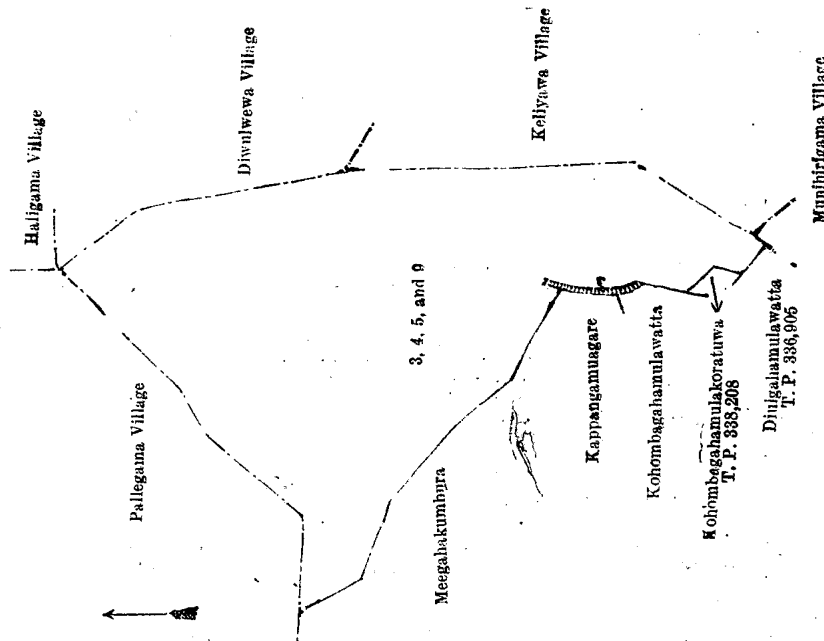

## Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

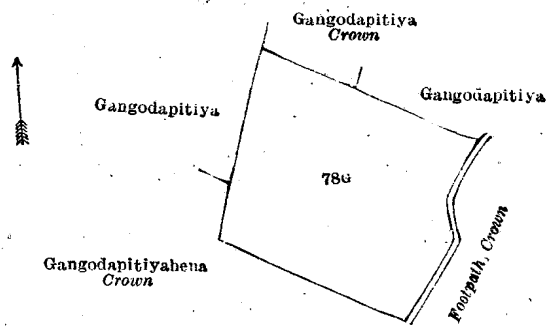
In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Gangodapitiya, situate in the village of Narangomuwa, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale south division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 1st day of December, 1916, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Gangodapitiya, situate in the village of Narangomuwa, in the Gampahasiya pattu of the Matale south division of the Matale District, in the Central Province, containing in extent 1 acre 3 roods and 34 perches, and shown as lot 78G in block survey preliminary plan 24 and in the annexed diagram, was made to John Murray Davies, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 6,090):
