
Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

The notice required by section 1 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," having been duly published in manner prescribed by that section in respect of the above-named land (vide Notice No. 6,453), and no claim having been made to the said land or to any interest therein within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, I, Maxwell Maclagan Wedderburn, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 2 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 21st day of December, 1920, order and declare that the said land, as more fully described herein below, situate in the village of Pahala Beligalla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and shown as lot 42 in block survey preliminary plan 285 and in the annexed diagram, and containing in entent 2 acres 3 roods and 7 perches. is the property of the Crown.
