Revenue Incentive Fund	102	<p>(a) A fund that shall be hereinafter referred to as “Fund” in this Section cited as “Revenue Incentive Fund” shall be established</p> <p>(b) An amount appropriated annually by the Western Province Provincial for the purpose of the Fund on behalf of each year shall be paid to the Fund</p> <p>(c) (i) Where a revenue has been earned on a statement and/or assessment made by an assessor considering the matters of conformation that the value stated in any instrument, the turnover stated in a report has been stated falsely when inspecting as per provisions of the statute ; and/or not producing reports prescribed to be presented by any statute executed by the Provincial Commissioner of Revenue ; and/or where as revenue has been collected when any tax/fee specified to be paid by a person as per provisions of any statute executed by Provincial Commissioner of Revenue has not been paid within the specified time period.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Twelve point five percent (12.5%) from the revenue collected thus.</p> <p>(ii) Five percent from the revenue collected through fines imposed under any statute executed by the Provincial Commissioner of Revenue.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Shall be credited to the Fund.</p> <p>(d) From the amount earned under the above mentioned percentages, the incentive for the officers shall be paid by the Fund according to a scheme formulated by the Commissioner of Revenue and approved by the Minister of Finance.</p> <p>(e) Provincial Commissioner of Revenue shall administer the Fund in compliance to the proper procedure of the aforementioned scheme.</p> <p>(f) The Commissioner, subjected to the approval of the Finance Minister shall formulate regulations as to which principles and conditions should be incentives be paid for relevant officers from the money lying at credit in the said Fund.</p>
