GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

ULE made by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 5 of "The Ceylon" Railways Ordinance, 1902 ":--

All paddy grown in the Island and consigned on and after May 2, 1921, from any station to any station on any of the lines of the Ceylon Government Railway shall be carried free of freight.

All previous rules regarding the free carriage and the exemption from all railway charges of rice or paddy are hereby cancelled with effect from May 2, 1921, and all rice and paddy other than paddy grown in the Island shall from the said date be subject to the usual railway charges.
