DRAFT ORDINANCES.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance further to amend "The Game Protection Ordinance, 1909."

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Game Protection Ordinance, 1909": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Game Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, No. of 1921."

2 Section 5 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the following proviso for the proviso to the said section:

Provided that whenever an elephant or buffalo kraal is held by permission of the Governor, the provisions of this Ordinance relating to the capture of elephants, tuskers, and buffaloes shall not apply. The Governor may, with regard to the elephants, tuskers, or buffaloes captured at any such kraal, order either that such sum as he shall think fit shall be paid by way of royalty, or that no such sum shall be charged.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

The object of the Bill is to take power to enable a buffalo kraal being held with a view to legalizing this method of capture of wild buffaloes. At present the practice is to capture wild buffaloes alive by noosing them, and experience has shown that this involves great suffering to the buffaloes, and is not very effective.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 7 of 1921.

An Ordinance to provide for the Recognition in this Colony of Probates and Letters of Administration granted in the United Kingdom and in British Possessions.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the recognition in this Colony of probates and letters of administration granted in the United Kingdom and in British Possessions: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The British and Colonial Probate Ordinance, No. 7 of 1921," and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor shall, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, appoint.

Interpretation.

- 2 In this Ordinance the expression-
- "Competent court" means any court appointed to have and exercise sole testamentary jurisdiction in respect of the estate in question under section 70 of "The Courts Ordinance, 1889."

"Court of Probate" means any court or authority by whatever name designated having jurisdiction in matters of probate.

"Probate" and "letters of administration" include confirmation in Scotland, and any instrument having in a British Possession the same effect as, under the law of this Colony, is given to probate and letters of administration respectively.

administration respectively.
"Testamentary duty" includes any duty payable on the value of the estate and effects for which probate or letters

of administration is or are granted.

"British court in a foreign country" means any British court having jurisdiction out of the King's Dominions in pursuance of an Order of His Majesty in Council, whether made under any Act or otherwise.

Application of Ordinance by Order in Council.

- 3 (1) The Governor may, on being satisfied that the Legislature of any British Possession has made adequate provision for the recognition in that Possession of probates and letters of administration granted by any District Court of this Colony, direct by Proclamation in the Government Gazette that this Ordinance shall, subject to any exceptions and modifications specified in such Proclamation, apply to that Possession.
- (2) Where it appears to the Governor in Executive Council that the Legislature of part of a British Possession has power to make the provision requisite for bringing this Ordinance into operation, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council, by Proclamation in the Government Gazette, to direct that this Ordinance shall apply to that part as if it were a separate British Possession, and thereupon, while such Proclamation is in force, this Ordinance shall apply accordingly.

British and colonial probates. 4 (1) Where a Court of Probate in the United Kingdom or in a British Possession to which this Ordinance applies has granted probate or letters of administration in respect of the estate of a deceased person, the probate or letters so granted may, on being produced and a copy thereof deposited with the competent court, be sealed with the seal of the court, and thereupon shall be of like force and effect and have the same operation in Ceylon as if granted by the court.

- (2) Provided that the court shall, before sealing the said probate or letters of administration under this section, be satisfied—
 - (a) That testamentary duty has been paid in respect of so much (if any) of the estate as is liable to testamentary duty in Ceylon; and
 - (b) In the case of letters of administration, that security has been given in a sum sufficient in amount to cover the property (if any) in Ceylon to which the letters of administration relate;

and may require such evidence, if any, as it thinks fit as to the domicile of the deceased person.

- (3) The court may also, if it thinks fit, on the application of any creditor, require, before the probate or letters of administration are sealed as aforesaid, that adequate security be given for the payment of the debts due from the estate to creditors residing in Ceylon.
- (4) For the purposes of this section a duplicate of any probate or letters of administration sealed with the seal of the Court of Probate granting the same, or a copy thereof certified as correct by or under the authority of such court, shall have the same effect as the original.
- (5) The sealing of the said probate or letters of administration shall not affect the liability of an executor or administrator—
 - (a) To file, within a time to be appointed by the court, an inventory of the deceased person's property and effects situated in Ceylon, with a valuation of the same, as required by section 538 of the Civil Procedure Code;
 - (b) To file, on or before the expiration of twelve months from the date of such sealing as aforesaid, a true account, as regards the deceased's property and effects situated in Ceylon, of his executorship or administration, as the case may be, verified on oath or affirmation, with all receipts and vouchers attached, as required by section 553 of the said Code;
 - (c) To be compelled to make a judicial settlement of his account as such executor or administrator, with respect to the deceased's property situated in Ceylon, under the provisions of chapter LV. of the said Code.
- ${\bf 5}$. For the purposes of all estates to which this Ordinance applies—
 - (a) All references in the Civil Procedure Code to any court as being the court from which grant of probate or letters of administration issued shall be construed as references to the competent court, and all references to the grant of probate or letters of administration or to an order absolute declaring a person entitled to such grant shall be construed as referring to the sealing of probate or letters of administration under this Ordinance.
 - (b) All references in "The Stamp Ordinance, 1909," to the grant of probate or letters of administration shall be deemed to include a reference to the sealing of probate or letters of administration under this Ordinance, and all references to probate or letters of administration shall be deemed to include a reference to any probate or letters of administration or to any duplicate or certified copy thereof sealed under this Ordinance.
- 6 It shall be competent for the Judges of the Supreme Court, or any three of them, of whom the Chief Justice shall be one, to make rules of court for regulating the procedure and practice, including fees and costs, on and incidental to an application for sealing a probate or letters of administration granted in the United Kingdom or in a British Possession to which this Ordinance applies, and to vary and revoke the same in the same manner as rules relating to practice and procedure, fees and costs, or to the duties of officers of court under the authority of "The Courts Ordinance, 1889," may be varied or revoked.

Rules of court.

Application of Ordinance.

7 This Ordinance shall extend to authorize the sealing as hereinbefore mentioned of any probate or letters of administration granted by a British court in a foreign country in like manner as it authorizes the sealing of a probate or letters of administration granted in a British Possession, and the provisions of this Ordinance shall apply accordingly with the necessary modifications.

Application of Ordinance to probate and letters already granted. 8 This Ordinance when applied by a Proclamation to any British Possession shall, subject to the provisions of such Proclamation, apply to probates and letters of administration granted in that Possession either before or after the commencement of this Ordinance.

An Ordinance to amend "The Wells and Pits Protection Ordinance, 1884."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Wells and Pits Protection Ordinance, 1884": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Wells and Pits Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 11 of 1921."

2 The principal Ordinance is amended by striking out section 8 and inserting in lieu thereof the following section:

8. The Government Agent or Assistant Government Agent of any district may appoint one or more persons to be inspectors of wells and pits within any area in such district, and such persons when so appointed shall have authority at all times to proceed to and inspect any well or pit within the respective areas for which they have been appointed, and every such inspector shall be deemed a public officer within the meaning of that term in the Ceylon Penal Code.

An Ordinance further to amend "The Former Enemy Aliens Ordinance, No. 19 of 1919."

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend "The Former Enemy Aliens Ordinance, No. 19 of 1919": Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Former Enemy Aliens (Amendment) Ordinance, No. 12 of 1921."

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 The definition of "Former enemy alien" in section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following definition shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
 - "'Former enemy alien' means an alien who is a subject or citizen of the German Empire or any component State thereof, or of Austria, Hungary, Bulgaria, or Turkey, or who having at any time been such subject or citizen, has not changed his allegiance as the result of the recognition of new States or territorial re-arrangements, or been naturalized in any other foreign State or in any British Possession in accordance with the laws thereof and when actually resident therein, and does not retain according to the law of his State of origin, the nationality of that State.
 - "Provided further that a woman who was at the time of her marriage a British subject shall not be taken to be a former enemy alien."

Insertion of new section in principal Ordinance.

Restrictions on acquisition of land.

- 3 There shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 6 thereof the following section, which shall be numbered 6 A:
 - 6 A. (1) It shall not be lawful for a former enemy alien, either in his own name or in the name of a trustee or trustees, to acquire any land or any interest in land in the Colony.
 - (2) The expression "interest in land" does not include a tenancy for a period not exceeding three years.
 - (3) If any land or interest in land as aforesaid is acquired in contravention of this section, the Governor in Executive Council may by order declare such property to be forfeited to His Majesty, and thereupon the same shall vest in His Majesty absolutely.
 - (4) Upon any Government Agent producing or causing to be produced such order before the District Court having jurisdiction within the district in which such property is situated, such court shall forthwith issue a writ of possession requiring the Fiscal or Deputy Fiscal of such district to put and place such Government Agent or any person whom he may name in writing in possession of such property for and on behalf of his Majesty, and, if need be, to remove therefrom any person refusing to vacate the same.

An Ordinance to facilitate the Enforcement in the Colony of Maintenance Orders made in England and Ireland and vice versa.

Preamble,

WHEREAS it is expedient to facilitate the enforcement in the Colony of maintenance orders made in England and Ireland and vice versa: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title and commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance, No. 15 of 1921," and shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by the Governor in Executive Council, by Proclamation published in the Government Gazette.

Interpretation.

2 For the purposes of this Ordinance, the expression "maintenance order" means an order other than an order of affiliation for the periodical payment of sums of money towards the maintenance of the wife or other dependants of the person against whom the order is made, and the expression "dependants" means such persons as that person is, according to the law in force in England, Ireland, or Ceylon, as the case may be, liable to maintain; the expression "certified copy" in relation to an order of a court means a copy of the order certified by the proper officer of the court to be a true copy.

Enforcement. in the Colony of maintenance orders made in England or Ireland.

3 Where a maintenance order has, whether before or after the passing of this Ordinance, been made against any person by any court in England or Ireland, and a certified copy of the order has been transmitted to the Governor by the Secretary of State, the Governor shall send a copy of the order to the prescribed officer of a Police Court in the Colony for registration; and on receipt thereof the order shall be registered in the prescribed manner, and shall, from the date of such registration, be of the same force and effect, and, subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, all proceedings may be taken on such order as if it had been an order originally obtained in the court in which it is so registered, and that court shall have power to enforce the order accordingly.

Transmission of maintenance orders made in the Colony. 4 Where a Police Court in the Colony has, whether before or after the commencement of this Ordinance, made a maintenance order against any person, and it is proved to that court that the person against whom the order was made is resident in England or Ireland, the court shall send to the Governor for transmission to the Secretary of State a certified copy of the order.

Power to make provisional orders of maintenance against persons resident in England or Ireland. 5 (1) Where an application is made to a Police Court in the Colony for a maintenance order against any person, and it is proved that that person is resident in England or Ireland, the court may, in the absence of that person, if after hearing the evidence it is satisfied of the justice of the application, make any such order as it might have made if a summons had been duly served on that person and he had failed to appear at the hearing, but in such case the order shall be provisional only, and shall have no effect unless and until confirmed by a competent court in England or Ireland.

(2) The evidence of any witness who is examined on any such application shall be put into writing, and such deposition

shall be read over to and signed by him.

(3) Where such an order is made, the court shall send to the Governor, for transmission to the Secretary of State, the depositions so taken and a certified copy of the order, together with a statement of the grounds on which the making of the order might have been opposed if the person against whom the order is made had been duly served with a summons and had appeared at the hearing, and such information as the court possesses for facilitating the identification of that person, and ascertaining his whereabouts.

- (4) Where any such provisional order has come before a court in England or Ireland for confirmation, and the order has by that court been remitted to the Police Court in the Colony which made the order for the purpose of taking further evidence, that court shall, after giving the prescribed notice, proceed to take the evidence in like manner and subject to the like conditions as the evidence in support of the original application. If upon the hearing of such evidence it appears to such Police Court that the order ought not to have been made, the court may rescind the order, but in any other case the depositions shall be sent to the Governor and dealt with in like manner as the original depositions.
- (5) The confirmation of an order made under this section shall not affect any power of a Police Court to vary or rescind that order. Provided that on the making of a varying or rescinding order the court shall send a certified copy thereof to the Governor, for transmission to the Secretary of State, and that in the case of an order varying the original order, the order shall not have any effect unless and until confirmed in like manner as the original order.
- (6) The applicant shall have the same right of appeal, if any, against a refusal to make a provisional order as he would have had against a refusal to make the order had a summons been duly served on the person against whom the order is sought to be made.
- 6 (1) Where a maintenance order has been made by a court in England or Ireland, and the order is provisional only, and has no effect unless and until confirmed by a Police Court in the Colony, and a certified copy of the order, together with the depositions of witnesses and a statement of the grounds on which the order might have been opposed has been transmitted to the Governor, and it appears to the Governor that the person against whom the order was made is resident in the Colony, the Governor may send the said documents to the prescribed officer of a Police Court, with a requisition that a summons be issued calling upon the person to show cause why that order should not be confirmed, and upon receipt of such documents and requisition the court shall issue such a summons and cause it to be served upon such person.

(2) At the hearing it shall be open to the person on whom the summons was served to raise any defence which he might have raised in the original proceedings had he been a party thereto, but no other defence, and the certificate from the court which made the provisional order stating the grounds on which the making of the order might have been opposed if the person against whom the order was made had been a party to the proceedings shall be conclusive evidence that those grounds are grounds on which objection may be taken.

(3) If at the hearing the person served with the summons does not appear or, on appearing, fails to satisfy the court that the order ought not to be confirmed, the court may confirm the order either without modification or with such modifications as to the court after hearing the evidence may seem just.

(4) If the person against whom the summons was issued appears at the hearing and satisfies the court that for the purpose of any defence it is necessary to remit the case to the court which made the provisional order for the taking of any further evidence, the court may so remit the case and adjourn the proceedings for the purpose.

(5) Where a provisional order has been confirmed under this section, it may be varied or rescinded in like manner as if it had originally been made by the confirming court, and where on an application for rescission or variation the court is satisfied that it is necessary to remit the case to the court which made the order for the purpose of taking any further evidence, the court may so remit the case and adjourn the proceedings for the purpose.

(6) Where an order has been so confirmed, the person bound thereby shall have the same right of appeal, if any, against the confirmation of the order as he would have had against the making of the order had the order been an order made by the court confirming the order.

Power of Police Court to confirm maintenance order made in England or Ireland. Power of Governor in Executive Council to make regulations for facilitating communications between courts.

Mode of enforcing orders.

Criminal Procedure Code to apply to proceedings under this Ordinance.

Proof of documents signed by officers of court.

Depositions to be evidence.

- 7 The Governor may make regulations as to the manner in which a case can be remitted by a court authorized to confirm a provisional order to the court which made the provisional order, and generally for facilitating communications between such courts.
- 8. (1) A court in the Colony in which an order has been registered under this Ordinance, or by which an order has been confirmed under this Ordinance, and the officers of such court, shall take all such steps for enforcing the order as may be prescribed.

(2) Every such order shall be enforceable as if it were an order made by such court under section 9 of "The Main-

tenance Ordinance, 1889."

- (3) A warrant of distress or commitment issued by the court for the purpose of enforcing any order so registered or confirmed may be executed in any part of the Colony in the same manner as if the warrant had been originally issued by a Police Court having jurisdiction in the place where the warrant is executed.
- 9 "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898," shall apply to proceedings before a Police Court under this Ordinance as it applies to proceedings under "The Maintenance Ordinance, 1889."
- 10 Any document purporting to be signed by an officer of a court of summary furisdiction in England or Ireland shall, until the contrary is proved, be deemed to have been so signed without proof of the signature or judicial or official character of the person appearing to have signed it, and the officer of a court by whom a document is signed shall, until the contrary is proved, be deemed to have been the proper officer of the court to sign the document.

11 Depositions taken in a court in England or Ireland may be received in evidence in proceedings before Police Courts under this Ordinance.
