Hambantota S. O. No. 1,666.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Tennepitahena alias Tennehena, situate in the village of Kakuluwamulla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."


Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 10th day of August, 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Tennepitahena alias Tennehena, situate in the village of Kakuluwamulla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 10 acres 1 rood and 10 perches, and shown as lot 1 i in block survey preliminary plan 273 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Thomas Graham Willett, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,480):

And whereas (1) Weda-arachchige Don Carolis and (2) Weda-arachchige Don Andris made claim thereto, and Arnold Langdon Crossman, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said claimants and the aforesaid Arnold Langdon Crossman, with the consent of His Excellency the Governor, came to an agreement in writing dated the 8th day of October, 1918, concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimants should be declared the purchasers of the said land upon payment on or before the 3rd day of July, 1919, to the Treasury Officer at Tangalla, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees One hundred and Sixty only (Rs. 160), as the purchase amount of the said land; and whereas the said amount has been duly paid by the said claimants, they are hereby, in pursuance of the agreement afore-mentioned, declared to be the purchasers of the said land, as more fully described herein below.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," declaring Land to be Crown Property.


In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Tennepitahena alias Tennehena, situate in the village of Kakuluwamulla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 10th day of August, 1917, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Tennepitahena alias Tennehena, situate in the village of Kakuluwamulla, in the West Giruwa pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, containing in extent 15 acres and 2 perches, and shown as lot 1 in block survey preliminary plan 273 and in the annexed diagram, was made to Thomas Graham Willett, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 6,480):
