##### SCHEDULE.

##### Negombo.

*North.*—A straight line drawn from the junction of Dalupota-oya with the canal due west to the sea.

*East.*—The Dalupota-oya from its junction with the canal to the culvert over the said oya on the Negombo-Minuwangoda road, and thence southwards along the western boundary of the Goluāpokuna estate to the Diyahonda-ela.

*South.*—The Diyahonda-ela (near the 20th milepost on the Colombo road) and a line drawn from the mouth of the

said ela due west across the Negombo lake to the southern boundary of the village of Pitipana, and along that boundary to the sea.

*West.*—The sea.

*Note.*—All islands situated within the above area are included.

## SCHEDULE.

*Moratuwa.*

*North.*—The stream known as the Lunawa river, the approach road to the Angulana railway station as far as its junction with the Colombo-Galle road. The line of the said approach road produced to a point 5 chains to the north-east of the Colombo-Galle road. From this point

a line drawn south-eastwards and southwards parallel to the Colombo-Galle road as far as the road known as the Katubedda Broadway; the Katubedda Broadway.

*East and South.*—The Panadure river.

*West.*—The sea.

## SCHEDULE.

*Ratnapura.*

*North.*—A straight line from the north-western boundary of T. P. 99,563 running eastwards direct to a point where it meets the railway line, thence southwards along the railway line to a point where it meets the railway bridge over the Katugas-ela, thence a straight line eastwards direct to a point 3 chains from the northernmost bend of the Outer Circular road, thence a straight line eastwards direct to a point 3 chains from the junction of the Mahawala estate road and Malwala road, thence a line running eastwards parallel with and 3 chains to the north of the Malwala road to where it meets the Magurankanagina-dola.

*East.*—Along the Magurankanagina-dola southwards to its junction with the Kalu-ganga, thence along the Kalu-ganga southwards to where it meets the Uman-dola, and along the Uman-dola to where it meets the Ehelapolawella, thence southwards along the Ehelapolawella to where it meets the Kirimeti-dola, and thence along the Kirimeti-dola

to where it meets the Ketan-dola, and thence along the Ketan-dola to where it meets the We-ganga.

*South.*—Along the We-ganga westwards to a point 3 chains to the south of the Karawita road, thence a line running parallel with and to the south of the Karawita road to a point where it meets the Madduwa village boundary.

*West.*—Along the village boundary of Madduwa and Muwagama northwards to where it meets the Podgolly trig, thence a straight line running north-eastward direct to a point where it meets the Muwagama totapala on the Kalu-ganga, thence along the Kalu-ganga westwards to a point where the Kotamba-ela meets the river, thence along the Kotamba-ela to a point where it meets the southern boundary of Galkaduwa-mukalana, thence a line following the southern and eastern boundary of Galkaduwa-mukalana to a point where it meets the north-western boundary of land in T. P. 99,563.
